OUR "YEAR TO DATE" TOTAL IS RUNNING A TRIFLE BEHIND LAST YEARS. WE NEED TO TAKE TIME OUT TO FIND A BLOOD BANK AND "HELP SAVE A LIFE". THANKS.

DID YOU KNOW? BLOOD BANKS BADLY NEED PHERESIS DONORS. SIMPLY PUT, THIS PROCEDURE DIFFERS FROM A REGULAR DONATION IN THAT THE DONOR'S BLOOD DOES NOT FLOW INTO A PLASTIC BAG BUT INTO AN AUTOMATED CELL SEPARATOR WHICH REMOVES THE DESIRED COMPONENTS AND RETURNS THE REMAINDER BACK TO THE DONOR. BLOOD IS MADE OF SEVERAL COMPONENTS - NOT ALL PATIENTS NEED ALL COMPONENTS, AND THIS ALLOWS THE BLOOD BANK TO USE ONLY THOSE NEEDED BY A PARTICULAR PATIENT AND USE THE REMAINING FOR OTHER PATIENTS. THIS PROCEDURE DOES TAKE A LITTLE LONGER, BUT THE JOY YOU RECEIVE FOR GIVING IS WELL WORTH THE TIME. TRY IT.
