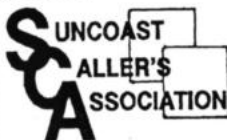

THE TEDDY BEAR MUSEUM OF NAPLES - THE BEAR FACTS

Mrs. Frances Pew Hayes, the Museum's founder, has seven (7) children, nineteen (19) grandchildren, and at last count, two (2) great grandchildren. To minimize the gift burden on each, the family draws member's names at Christmas time for gift giving. About 1984, the grandson who drew her name, telephoned and asked what she wanted for Christmas. Mrs. Hayes replied that she was always running out of rubberbands and paper clips, and he could give her those. However, the little boy was very wise. He knew what others would think if he gave his grandmother rubberbands and paper clips for Christmas, so he asked her to think of something else. Since it was the Chinese year of the bear, she asked for a teddy bear.

From this one friendly, snuggly "M&M" bear given as a Christmas present by a five year old to his grandmother, a teddy bear collection and this museum was born. She was completely enamored by the cute, cuddly teddy, and soon became a true "Arctophile" or teddy bear lover. Very quickly the number grew both from her travels as well as gifts from family, friends, and strangers. Soon there were bears and bearaphrenalia of all sizes and shapes. As the collection grew so did the number of requests from others of all ages to see it. Thus, the idea of and need for the museum was born.

The museum became a reality on December 19, 1990 when "Frannie", 1,500 donated bears, the staff, and volunteers opened the doors of THE TEDDY BEAR MUSEUM OF NAPLES to the public as a not-for-profit, public corporation.

Today, our "hug" of more than 2,500 bears call this 8,000 square-foot, cedar wood, air conditioned, earth toned building their home or "den". Through donations and acquisitions, the number is ever increasing.

As you tour the rooms and view the mechanical and static displays, notice the signs which indicate if you are in the "Libeary" or Artists', Manufacturers, or "Antique" areas. Notice also that each bear wears a numbered inventory tag and has a sign which gives its company name, artist/designer, city, state and country of origin. More information about individual bears is available at the front desk. Special information may be available in our archive by special request.
