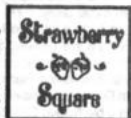

51st NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION ACTIVITIES

TRAIL DANCES - Dances held "on-the-trail to the National Square Dance Convention. These dances may be sponsored by any group and celebrates the visitation of dancers passing through their area "on-the-way" to the National Convention.

TRAIL END DANCES - Trail End Dances are held the night before the official start of the convention (Wednesday), at the site of the National Convention, and signifies that the travelers have reached the "end-of-the-trail" to the convention.

There may be several Trail End Dances conducted at the convention facilities or local hotels, motels, or other dance facilities.

SQUARE DANCING - All levels (programs) of square dancing are provided at the convention. From 300 to 500 callers participate at the convention calling from 10 AM till 10 PM each day and then calling another two hours at various after parties. Hall size varies and may contain space for 45 squares, 100 squares, 240 squares, and even the large arenas are used.

ROUND DANCING - Over 125 Round Dance Teachers attend the convention to cue and teach rounds at every level (phase) including an introduction to rounds for beginners.

CONTRA DANCING - Contra prompters conduct sessions for accomplished Contra Dancers as well as introductory sessions. Contra is increasing in the square dance activity and 30 prompters were in attendance at the 47th National Square Dance Convention.

CLOGGING - About 20 - 30 clogging instructors attend the convention to conduct a full clogging program each day.

COUNTRY WESTERN LINE DANCING - Country Western and Line Dancing is also presented at the National Square Dance Conventions. Due to its popularity, it is rapidly growing within the square dance movement. Twenty three instructors were teaching at the 47th National Square Dance Convention. This is only an example, the emphasis on Country Western will vary depending on the location of the National Square Dance Convention.

COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS CONSIDER LIFE IN THE 1500'S

Bread was divided according to status. Workers got the burnt bottom of the loaf, the family got the middle, and guests got the top, or "upper crust".

Lead cups were used to drink ale or whiskey. The combination would sometimes knock them out for a couple of days. Someone walking along the road would take them for dead and prepare them for burial. They were laid out on the kitchen table for a couple of days and the family would gather around and eat and drink and wait and see if they would wake up-hence the custom of holding a "wake".

England is old and small and they started running out of places to bury people. So they would dig up coffins and would take the bones to a "bone-house and reuse the grave.

When reopening these coffins, one out of 25 coffins were found to have scratch marks on the inside and they realized they had been burying people alive. So they thought they would tie a string on the wrist of the corpse, lead it through the coffin and up through the ground and tie it to a bell. Someone would have to sit out in the graveyard all night (the "graveyard shift") to listen for the bell; thus, some one could be "saved by the bell" or was considered a "dead ringer".

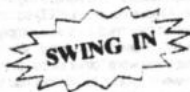

RECRUITING AND YOU

This is a continuation of the response Ann & Don Stocum received to their request for ideas on recruiting and maintaining dancers. It was from Karin Strickland. Edited due to space constraints.

IDEA Number 9

I will point out something that is probably known to everyone but no one will admit:

Not everyone is a good teacher. A person may have many fine qualities but they may be a very bad teacher. They may be a fine dancer and a great caller, but a HORRIBLE teacher.

This happened to our class. We started with about 10 couples. Because the teacher yelled at people, called them names, made fun of them, made it obvious that he thought they were stupid (via what he'd say, rolling eyes, etc.) we LOST 4 couples (plus one woman) - who will obviously NEVER come back to square dancing: "We tried it and everyone was so MEAN". I was friendly enough with every couple to know for certain why they left (so this isn't supposition, it's fact).

The teacher yelled at me, too, but we realized that the whole of Square Dancing was not embodied by that one person. We wanted to keep dancing - so we looked for a solution - and found other clubs to try! We found several clubs where the people are very nice and we enjoy ourselves. But I can see where there were so many couples who would be good, nice, fun dancers today but they were "chased away" by this teacher. I'm saddened by this because we lost some very nice people/dancers. The ironic thing is that every one of those couples LIKED square dancing when they tried it - it was simply the treatment that chased them away. We hadn't known that there were "other clubs" to try. I know of several people NOW that had they switched to one of these other teachers, they would (be in square dancing today).

He's even told people to "Don't Come Back" when he's gotten upset about them making a mistake - this is very bad. I don't know what to do about this problem.

I recognize that you can't say to a bad teacher "We won't let you teach", BUT I bring this up because I think that you callers should try to discuss this problem. I'm sure you know that this problem exists, but have been reluctant to tackle it because it's VERY
