## LET'S PUT "DANCE" BACK IN SQUARE DANCING!

Could it be that we are losing some of our dancers because we no longer dance in our squares? We all were taught how to maneuver through the calls, how to position the hands, how many steps or beats of music were required to complete the call and how to move with style.

You've seen this: the caller said "Heads promenade half-way." The sides start to move forward, but instead of Promenading one or both the head couples burst down the center of the square like a Mac truck out of control. The next time this is called, the sides are ready, the heads aren't going to get away with that trick again. We'll form a blockade, they will have to go around. After the collision and much pushing and shoving, the heads eventually get where they are supposed to be but it's too late and now they have to scramble real fast to catch up to the call. THIS IS DANCING?

The call is Square Through Four Hands. Sam Knowitall simply turns and faces his corner. After the other three have recovered from shock, there may still be time if we rush to catch up to the call.

The call is Grand Square. I know it requires 32 steps. I've done it in 24, maybe I can do it in 20. Now what can I do until the caller catches up? THIS IS DANCING?

Dancing is moving the body and feet rhythmically to music and a series of rhythmic movements and steps timed to music. We must take some positive steps to encourage and convince new people and the veteran dancers that square dancing really is fun.

As a first step towards fixing whatever is wrong with square dancing, why don't we try to make this the year that we put the "dance" back in square dancing?

## **EDITORIAL COMMENT by William Boyd**

"Whatsoever the mind of man can conceive and believe – man can achieve". While this is often quoted it is also a bunch of bunk. Your motivational seminars leave something out. They tell you if you can conceive and believe, you can achieve. So where are our new dancers?


Square dancing is not dying. Square dancing is not growing as fast as we would like. One of the problems is in finding people to take responsibility and initiative. How much initiative? How much responsibility? Uh oh this looks like work. Yes it does and yee it is! Let us start with something simple. Classes – every year at least once a year we should have classes to introduce new people to our recreational activity. Are you the person willing to make sure that Square Dancing Grows?

Most of the readers of this magazine know that I love Square Dance Conventions. Those who know me also know that I love to dance at club level. Club level and new dancers are the backbone of our fun. I feel that this newsletter has been all over the topics but sometimes I just like to run off at the keyboard and say what I feel. Keep dancing and have fun.

OKC hosted the 4th NSDC in 1955; General Chairmen — our beloved Howard and Peggy Thornton.

## CAMPING AT THE 52ND



Camping for the 52nd National Square Dance Convention will be at the Oklahoma State Fair Park.

The Fair Park is located in Oklahoma City, just northwest of the intersection of I-40 and I-44, only 4.1 miles west of our great convention facilities, with three easy-access inbound traffic routes — I-40, Reno Ave., or NW 10th street.

There are 330 permanent campsites, (no 'pull-throughs') with water and 20 amp electrical service; and two dump stations. The campsites are on level grassy land with paved roads around the western half of the park and gravel roads in the eastern half. Restrooms and shower facilities are located at the campgrounds. The campsites will be assigned not by early arrival, but by early registration. If needed, additional temporary campsites will be added.
