GOURMET GREEN BEANS

- 2 Pkgs. Frozen Green Beans
- 1 Can Golden Mushroom Soup
- 1/3 C Milk
- 1 T Soy Sauce
- 1/8 t Pepper
- 1/4 t Laury Salt
- 1 Can French Fried Onions

Cook and drain beans as directed on the package. Put in greased 1 qt. casserole. Blend soup, milk, soy sauce, pepper and Laury salt. Stir into beans and blend. Add onions last and blend gently. Bake 25 minutes at 350 degrees.

PUMPKIN BREAD

- 3 C Sugar
- 4 Eggs
- 2/3 C Water
- 1 No. 2 Can Pumpkin
- 1 or 2 t Cinnamon "to taste"
- 1 C Oil
- 1 1/2 t Salt
- 2 t Soda
- 3 1/3 C Flour

Mix sugar, oil and eggs in power mixer. Sift flour, salt, cinnamon and soda together. Add pumpkin and water to sugar, add flour and mix all together. Pour into (4) pans 7 1/2" x 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" you have greased and lined the bottoms with was paper. Bake 1 hour at 350 degrees.
