KITCHEN TALK

MERRY CHEESE BALL

- 1 8 oz. pkg. Cream Cheese (softened)
- 1 C Pecans (finely chopped)
- 1 Clove Garlic (minced) "or bottled minced garlic"
- 1 to 2 T Bottled Steak Sauce
- few drops Tobasco Sauce
- Chopped Parsley
- Paprika

With beater or spoon, combine cream cheese, steak sauce, nuts, garlic and tobasco sauce. Form in ball, wrap in waxed paper or food wrap, chill several hours or until firm. Unwrap ball and place on serving dish. Sprinkle parsley to make strip about 1" wide down center of ball. Sprinkle each side with paprika. Keep chilled. Remove from refrigerator about 15" before serving. Serve with crackers. MAKES 1 1/2-Cups.

CHERRY JELLO APPLE-SAUCE

- 1 Can (12 oz.) Ginger Ale
- 1 Box Cherry Jello (small)
- 1 C Apple Sauce

Heat (not boil) ale, and pour into bowl with cherry jello, stir until dissolved, add apple sauce mix well. Chill and serve.

Dissolve 2 boxes (small) cherry jello in 1 C boiling water, add 1 1/2 C cold water, stir 1 can whole cranberry sauce; drain 1 can crushed pineapple and add to cranberry mixture. Pour into mold and chill.
