TABLE TALK

"EDNA'S POPPY SEED CAKE"

- 1-pkg. Duncan Hines Yellow Cake Mix
- 1-pkg. Jello Instant Coconut Pudding
- 4-Eggs
- 1/2-C Crisco Oil
- 1-C Hot Water
- 1/4-C Poppy Seed

Mix together and beat 4 to 5 minutes. Pour into Bundt or Angel Food pan that has been well greased. Bake 50 minutes at 350 degrees. Cake should cool in pan before removal.

CORN CUSTARD PUDDING

- | | |
|---------------------------------------|-------------------|
| 1 1/2 T Cornstarch | 2 T Butter melted |
| 1 1/2 T Sugar | 1/4 t Paprika |
| 3 Large Eggs, slightly beaten | 1/2 t Salt |
| 1 Can Cream Style Golden Corn (1-lb.) | 1 C Milk |

Blend together the cornstarch, salt and sugar, gradually stir in the milk and stir until smooth. Add eggs one at a time and beat gently to combine all thoroughly. Stir in the can of corn and melted butter. Pour into glass dish about 6" x 10" and sprinkle paprika on top. Place dish in pan of hot water so that water is as high as corn. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 to 45 minutes or until a silver knife inserted in center comes out clean.

In November, Edythe Andrus sent this editor a very good article to print in our magazine. That month, space wouldn't allow it, but now I do have room. I'm sorry, Edythe, to be so late with this.

This is a reprint from "Prevention":

My wife & I have been square dancing about as long as we have been reading Prevention which was in the early 50's. But there has been an ironic twist of fate for my daughters and me. We have been forced to quit because we suddenly discovered the reason for our headaches, hangovers, & illness. We found that it was exercising in a tobacco smoke atmosphere. My symptoms were considerably worse than my daughters'! For years I have suffered from almost continual headaches, nausea and too often all night vomiting sessions, chest pains, breathing and sleeping problems and aches and pains that had no apparent cause and for which various doctors could find no answers. Then through a series of tests I found that I was seriously allergic to smoke. Exposure to even part of a burning cigarette would bring on high blood pressure (220/140) and all of the above symptoms. Now my usual blood pressure is 130/90 at 50 years old. I was advised to stay out of all tobacco smoke to avoid a stroke that could be fatal. Another strange occurrence from all this is that I have been retired by the U.S. Civil Service Comm. with a medical retirement for the simple reason I cannot work in a tobacco smoke atmosphere. I really believe I am the first to be retired for this reason, but I don't think I will be the last. I was fortunate in finding a doctor that could recognize the serious problem and have the fortitude to say it on paper. And so, until square dance clubs enforce a clean air policy, square dancing cannot be the healthful exercise that many people claim it is.
