SHORTCUT SAUERBRATEN

|---------------------------|---|
| 1/4 cup flour | 2/3 cup cider vinegar |
| 2 tsp. salt | 1 1/2 cup water |
| 2 lbs. boneless stew beef | 2 tsp. brown sugar |
| 2 Tblsp. oil | 6 gingersnaps, crumbled |
| 1 cup chopped onion | Bouquet Garni (4 peppercorns, 4 cloves, 2 bay leaves) tie in a bag. |

Flour and salt the meat - heat oil - brown meat - stir in onion - mix vinegar, water, sugar and add garni. Cover and simmer 1 1/2 to 2 hours. Stir in crumbs and thicken gravy. Serves 6
