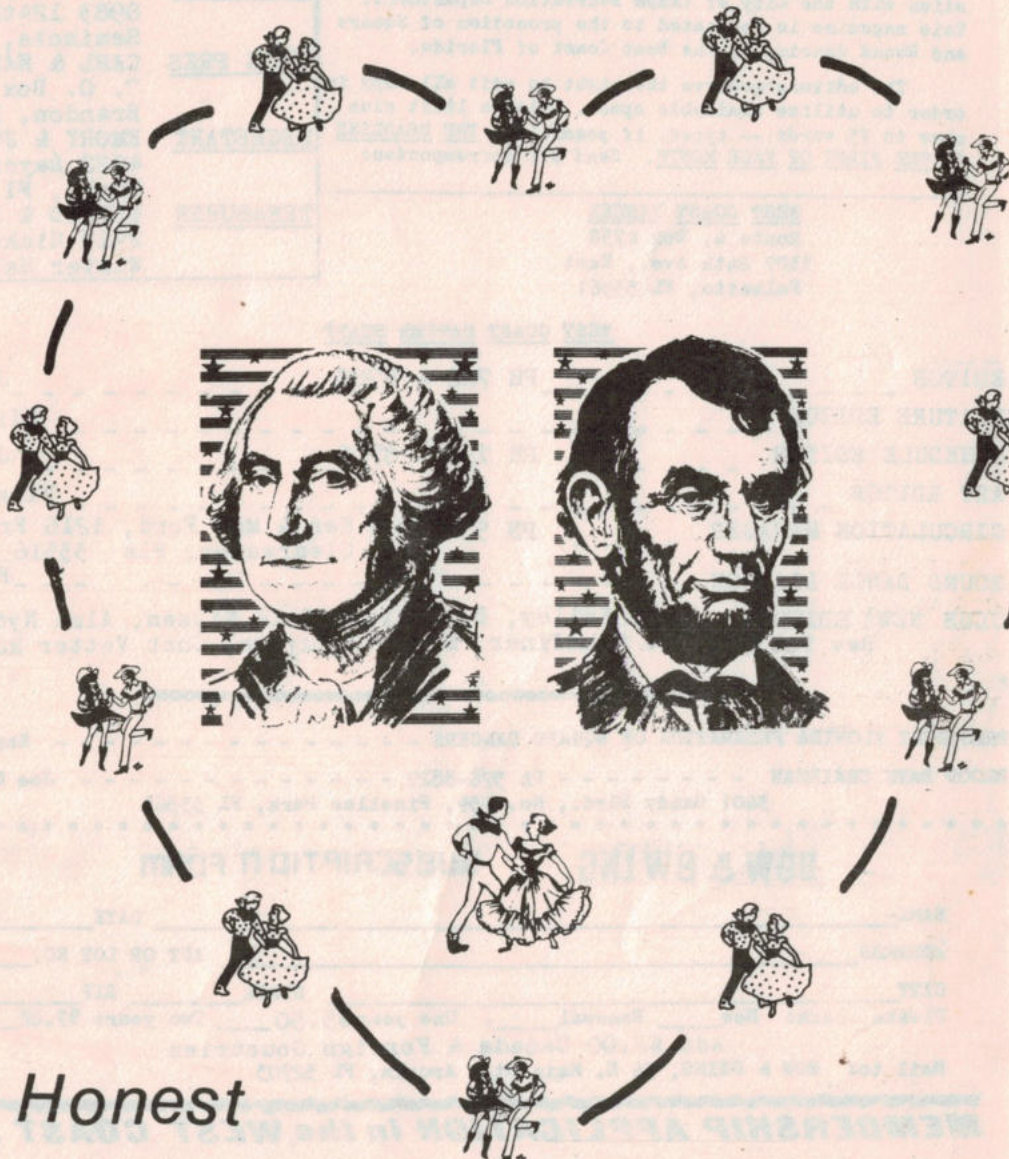

We'd like to suggest a short work/shop on the following 2 Round Dance Basics.....similar, but different. 1. The BREAKAWAY, and 2. HAND TO HAND (an international basic found in latin rhythms, such as Rumba and ChaCha. Here is the BREAKAWAY as taken from the URDC MANUAL, page IV-B-5:-

"Breakaway L or R. This figure is used in most all rhythms when adjusted to the timing. The full figure would include two measures of music but often only one measure is used to include either a "L" or "R" action. The "Hand to Hand" basic is different. The Cue Term is Breakaway L or R. Figure starts fcg Ptr generally in Bfly Pos. Cpl may be fcg any direction. The L Breakaway requires M's L and W's R free. The R Breakaway M's R and W's L free. The description given is in Two Step timing with Cpl Bfly Pos M fcg Wall, M's weight on R ft and W on L.

MAN

- B 1. Sd L starting trn RF releasing M's R and W's L hnds, keeping hnds shoulder high.
- B 2. Continue RF trn to fc RLOD step Bk on R in Bk checking action leaving L ft in place. Do not drop bk on heel. This is a L-Open Pos.
- B-F 3. Push fwd to replace weight on L ft trng LF to fc Ptr in Bfly Pos touching R beside L,-;

WOMAN

The action will be exactly like the M's except with opposite footwork turns.

Cue Term: "R BREAKAWAY" :- After finishing the L Breakaway the weight is on M's L and W's R. The R Breakaway is then done exactly the same as the L except both M & W will use opposite footwork & trng action to end in Bfly Pos fcg Wall weight on M's R and W's L.

- - - * - - -

HAND TO HAND, as taken from the URDC MANUAL page IV-H-15:
The Latin rhythms such as Rumba, Cha Cha, etc. use this figure which differs from the BREAKAWAY in that the free foot is used to step back on step one, whereas the BREAKAWAY, first step is to the side. Generally two measures are used. The following description is detailed in the Rumba timing starting in Bfly Pos fcg Wall, weight on M's R and W's L. Cue Term: "HAND TO HAND" (if two measures are used add the term "TWICE".)

MAN

- B-F (Q) 1. Drop M's L and W's R hnds keeping them about shoulder high trn LF 1/2 step Bk on L leaving R in place,
- B-F (Q) 2. Rec on R trng RF to Bfly,
- B-F (S) 3. Sd L twd LOD,
4. Hold one beat;

If the second measure is used repeat the action except the opposite footwork and turns are used.
