LEGACY 1983 Dancer Survey

The following should be of some interest to 114 dancers in the West Coast area who took the time to fill out a dancer survey last winter. There were a total of 5,481 forms returned from all areas, making for 208,000 data points on the computer and 127 pages of comments. It was obvious that much thought went into most forms, and the comments showed the respect and love for our activity.

Some of the following percentages will not be valid for our area due to the very large number of retired who dance.

The average respondent danced 4-5 times a month and had danced for 5 years. About 2/3rds had been club officers and 1/4th of these had attended a square dance leadership seminar. Of those attending 2/3rds felt the material was useful. The older the dancer experience the less interest in club and leadership.

On the question "What do you feel the most significant reason for dropouts"? the percentages were as follows: felt pressure towards higher levels, 38%; rushed, inadequate time to learn, 28%; social, not fully accepted, 21%; caller, inadequate in some way, 13%; club responsibilities, 11%; bored, not enough variety, 11% and rough and non-standard moves, 8%. Totals equal more than 100% as some forms were marked in more than one place.

On the scale of +5 - -5 of likes and dislikes it broke down as follows: pleasure of dancing, 4.3; doing things with friends, 3.9; exercise, 3.6; new acquaintances, 3.3; learning new things, 2.8; getting out, 2.5; challenge, 2.4; cost, 1.9; club activities, 1.5; clothes, 1.5 and rounds, 1.3.

The next survey will come out in the fall of 1984 and will again be printed in this magazine.
