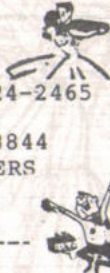

SOME WEST COAST FACTS THAT SHOULD BE OF INTEREST

The West Coast Association is primarily a communication network with the added niceties of a 500 unit BLOOD BANK and to a lesser degree supplies insurance to some clubs and itself. The West Coast Dancer (5000 plus copies per month) is the communicator. The Dancer, including paper and printing costs about \$4500 a year. Badges, bars and notices is \$400 in postage. West Coast Dances have a price tag of \$1200 with most new members and one half of the renewals picked up at these dances. Bars and badges for members run \$2000. The total of these costs is over \$8000. The West Coast receives money from the Fall Fun Fest, donations and by far the most from new members and renewals. Membership funds last year were under \$6,000. In the last two years membership has dropped almost 500 to 2600, but the distribution of the Dancer has gone over 5000. At one copy per couple this would total 10,000 dancers of which only 2600 were members; or, hundreds of copies of the Dancer are being wasted. Maybe a combination of both. THINK ABOUT IT !!!!!

BANNER STEALING

GUIDELINES

The object of banner stealing is to promote friendly visits between clubs. Do not over patronize a select few. Spread your club around. If you are going to be a banner bandit, be a good one, abide by the guidelines and make a practice of retrieving your banner before stealing someone else's.

1. A minimum of four couples from the raiding club, paying guest admission, constitute a banner raiding party.
2. One full square should be present for the first and last tip.
3. A banner raiding party may not retrieve and steal banners at the same dance.
4. It is permissible for a raiding club to determine in advance if a banner is available but banners are not to be reserved.
5. There is no restrictions on the number of traveling banners a club may have. IOU's are not recommended.
6. The first full raiding party to sign the guest register should be awarded the traveling banner. Additional banners should be awarded in the same manner.
7. A period of at least one month should pass before a club steals another club's banner a second time.
8. It is discourteous for a banner to remain in limbo more than three months.
9. Banners should be available at any open dance on the club's regular dance night and location unless advertised not available.
10. Banners should not be stolen from clubs who dance on the same night.
