NEW FLORIDA SQUARE DANCE OUTFIT

FABRIC: Buy the material at Walmart in order to maintain the same pastel colors. The rainbow colors are all Spring Palencia (SP) combed broadcloth and sold for \$1.87/yard with a slightly heavier white fabric a Polished Pearl (PP) @ \$3/yard so that the hidden pastel panels will not show through at rest. Colors and total yardage for the entire outfit are as follows based on Size 12 (adjust - or - as needed):

PP (White #606) 4 2/3 yards
SP (Blue #5276 & Light Green) 1 1/4 yards each
SP (Daffodil #01217 & Soft Pink #01834) 1 1/8 yards each

SKIRT PATTERN: For the white outside gores use any 8-gore skirt pattern w/ no ruffles. Pin pattern gore to white fabric lengthwise w/ the grain and cut 8. To make the inside gore pattern; fold both long edges of outside gore pattern toward each other until the top is about 3" across and the bottom hemline edges angle out to about 11" across. Trace onto paper & label. Pin inside gore pattern to each pastel color lengthwise w/ the grain, cut 2 each.

SEWING SKIRT: Stitch panels together w/ 1/2" seams in the following order: yellow, white, blue, white, pink, white, green, white & repeat. Press seams open. Wrong side out measure 9" @ seam on yellow/white panel and mark. Holding both adjacent yellow/white panels, pin together (keep seams even). Slightly left of seam, stitch together waist to marked point to form pleat & backstitch. Repeat forming 8 pleats. Press pleats meeting outside gores; hiding colored gores. Baste 1/4" across top raw edge to hold pressed panels flat. At waist attach bias hem facing to form casing for 1" elastic. Measure & hem skirt.

BLOUSE PATTERN: Use front & back of simple peasant blouse pattern & tiered cap sleeve pattern. Cut front & back blouse from PP. Sew as directed. Tiered cap sleeves are yellow & green w/ yellow at top. Sew as directed & attach to blouse body. To make neck ruffle cut blue 2 strips 17 1/2" x 7" on fold line (35" x 14"). Sew together to form circle w/narrow hem top & bottom of lengthwise raw edges. Sew wrong side of ruffle to right side of blouse, allowing 3/4" above top of blouse. Sew through ruffle & blouse to make casing for 1/4" elastic.

BOWS: Cut 2 strips each pastel (3 pink) diagonal to the grain 1 1/4" x 14 1/2". W/ rt. sides together fold in 1/2" lengthwise. Stitch w/ 1/4" seam allowance and trim. Thread needle; take a stitch in bias at one end; pass needle, eye first, through tubing. Press. Knot ends. Attach one each to bottom pleat juncture on skirt. Attach remaining pink below gathers on blouse top.

MAN'S SHIRT: For back yoke pattern, trace yoke of finished white shirt; measuring widest point of yoke across the back; divide by 4 and add seam allowance. Cut 4 strips (one each pastel color). Sew together. Press seams open. Cut out yoke from pattern. Repeat process for front yokes. Colors order facing shirt blue & yellow on left; green & pink on right.

48 HOURS IN INDIANAPOLIS - by Stephanie Hinds (excerpts) If someone would have told me 20 years ago they were going to spend two days having fun in Indianapolis, I would have assumed they either really liked bowling and suburban shopping malls, or they were just really desperate to get away from home. Today, however, when anyone tell me they're coming to Indy for two days, I encourage them to spend at least five. The city formerly touted as "India-no-place" and "Nap Town" has developed into an energetic city packed with arts and culture, internationally known sporting events, spirited night-life, an eclectic collection of restaurants and stores and a diversity of people who make up the heart of this flourishing city.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Check in at a downtown hotel such as the Canterbury Hotel, built in 1929. They pride themselves on attentive service w/a European flair, w/high tea and bedtime chocolate truffles.
