RECRUITING AND YOU

This is a continuation of the response Ann & Don Slocum received to their request for ideas on recruiting and maintaining dancers. It was from Karin Strickland.

IDEA Number 12

Still on the senior condos, even if you cannot become a sponsored activity in that condo (you definitely will be able to do so in many of the condos); you will still want to target that condo.

Put ads in the papers they get (the Activities Bulletin, the Senior News, etc.) and post things on their bulletin board.

IDEA Number 13

This idea actually falls out of the target the condo idea, but I wanted to mention it as a separate idea for discussion.

Perhaps other dancers ("Angels") would even be willing to pick someone up from the condos who can't drive. Imagine if even half the dancers were willing to pick up and drive someone who is alone and cannot drive. Many would be willing but have never thought of it -- and wouldn't know how to go about finding someone to assist.

But if the association was targeting the condo, and said on the ad "We will pick you up and drive you home", you could then ask for help in this regard from other dancers.

There might be a need for this for one night (the bring a friend event or a special night for that condo, for example), or possibly even for the long term for one dancer to pick up someone from the condo every week if they live nearby.

IDEA Number 14

Similar to "Bring a Friend" night, have a "XYZ Condo night" at your club. Advertise it heavily for that ONE condo, and maybe even have a shuttle to/from (although the condo might not allow it on premises).

This is in addition to the "targeting the condo" idea, because that is talking about setting up to get people into lessons from that condo. However, what I mean here is a combination of this idea and the "bring a friend" idea -- a ONE NIGHT that's "special" for this condo -- "Come on out and see what Square Dancing is all about". From then,

it's the same as to "Bring a Friend Event", but the point being that if you have the "one special night for XYZ condo", many more people WOULD be willing to "see what it's like" for one night versus if they saw an ad for lessons and that might be "too much".

But maybe once they SAW how much fun people are having, and that it's other seniors.....

IDEA Number 15

Target other types of dancers:
Line, as mentioned previously.

But also: Ballroom and Swing.

We love ballroom but we found that square dancing is even more fun -- not only because of the dancing but because of the friendship and the fun of dancing with other people in one square (where you all have to work together).

I.E. Ads where other types of dancers dance or in those types of magazines.

IDEA Number 16

Some of the people who quit square dancing do so because they can no longer keep up. Would there be a market for a slow/easy club for those elderly who know how to dance but their bodies just can no longer keep up?

Hey, here's an idea: maybe the club could start earlier -- with the "easy/slow" tips a half hour early.

At least down here in South Florida, usually the older people tend to leave earlier anyway, so that the faster dancers are left, and the Hot Hash type can be say, the last half hour?

Something like:

7:00 -- 7:30: Slow/Easy Tips

7:30 -- 9:30: Standard Plus w/Rounds

OR

If you have some young, fast dancers:

7:00 -- 7:30: Slow/Easy Tips

7:30 -- 9:00: Standard Plus w/Rounds

9:00 -- 9:30: Hot Hash

Maybe not all clubs but something like this might help out some of the elderly who are having a hard time due to their age?....

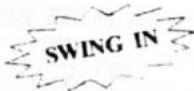

- Callers and Taws of the Suncoast Association who were there to call free of charge and to dance with their new graduates.

No matter what their reason for being there, they all had a great time. What better way to introduce new dancers to the joys of festival dancing and the forming of new friendships.

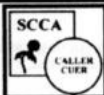
