We have started a new Raffle for a \$500 CASH prize to be given away at the State Convention. See your area Ways & Means Chairman for tickets.

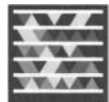

I hope everyone had a happy holiday and that you enjoyed your time with family and friends.

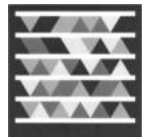
