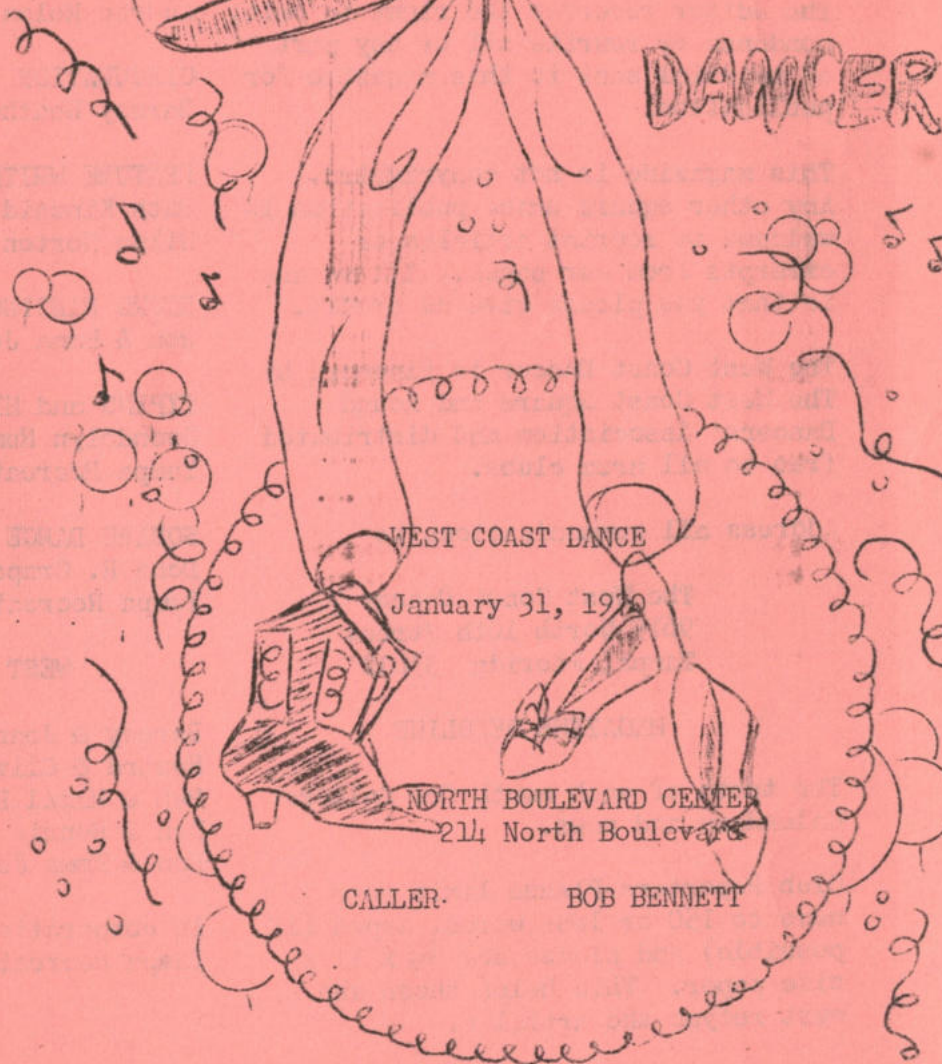

KITCHEN TALK

ZUCCHINI GUMBO

as prepared for the ESSEX DOWNS fourth Sunday DANCE

- 4-small zucchini squash, cut in bite size
- 4-small onions, cut in bit size
- 1-lb., okra cut in bite size
- 2-cans tomatoes
- $\frac{1}{4}$ -C bacon drippings (can use oil)

SAUTE vegetables in large fry pan until same are tender, add tomatoes and simmer 5 minutes.

SALT and PEPPER TO TASTE.

OATMEAL CAKE

- 1-C oatmeal
- 1-C sugar
- 1-Stick oleo or butter
- 1-t soda
- 1-t cinnamon
- 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ C "ALL PURPOSE" flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$ -C boiling water
- 1-C brown sugar
- 2-eggs
- 1-t baking powder
- $\frac{1}{2}$ -t salt

Soak oats in boiling water for 20 minutes. Combine sugar, oleo and eggs. Beat well, stir in oats and fold in sifted dry ingredients. Bake in 9" x 13" x 2" pan at 350 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes.

TOPPING

- 6-T butter
- $\frac{1}{2}$ -C B. sugar
- 1-C chopped nuts or coconut or combine them.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ -C cream
- 1-t vanilla

Combine all ingredients and spread over cake as it comes from oven, place under broiler and slightly brown. Please NO BURN.
