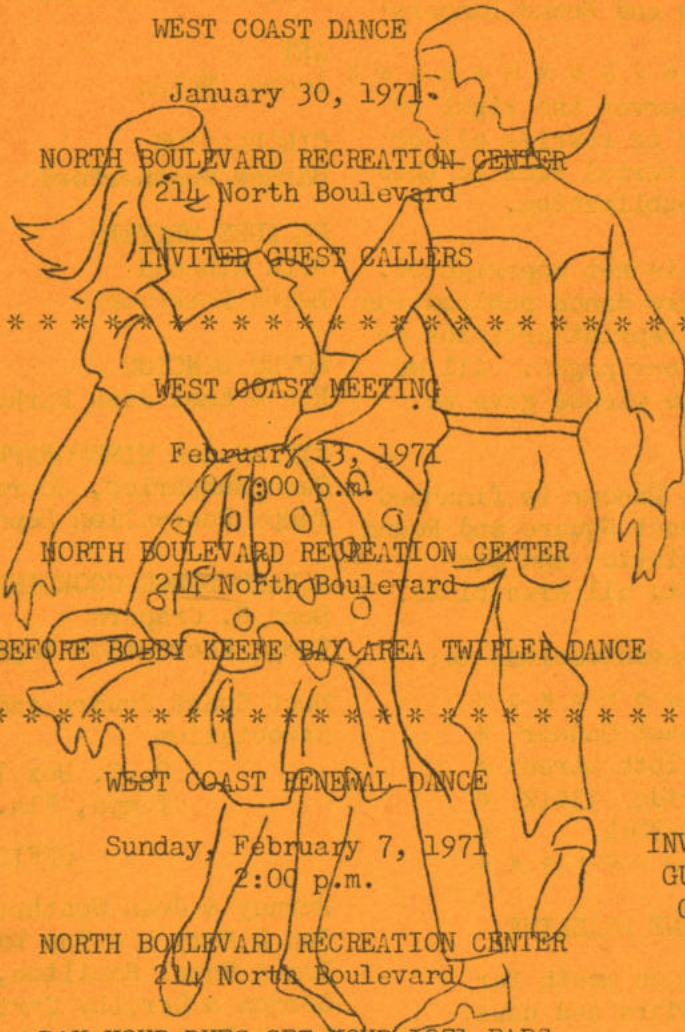

MARBLE-TOP CHOCOLATE RUM PIE

$\frac{1}{2}$ C Sugar	$\frac{1}{3}$ C Rum
1 T Gelatin (unflavored)	2 Egg Whites
1 C Milk	$\frac{1}{4}$ C Sugar
2 Beaten Egg Yolks	1 C Whipping Cream
1 Pkg. (6 oz.) Semi Sweet Chocolate pieces	1 t Vanilla
DASH of Salt	1 Baked 9" Pastry Shell

In heavy sauce pan, combine the $\frac{1}{2}$ -C sugar, the gelatin, and salt. Stir in milk and egg yolks. Cook stirring constantly over low heat until slightly thickened. Remove from heat; add chocolate pieces, stir until melted. Add rum. Chill until partially set. Beat egg whites until soft peaks form. Add gradually the $\frac{1}{4}$ -C sugar, beating until stiff peaks form. Fold into chocolate mixture in pastry shell, ending with whipped cream. Swirl the top to marble. Chill until firm, and serve. Note: If you desire you can make day before use and freeze. Remove from freezer morning of use and place in the refrigerator, about 3 to 4 hours prior to serving remove from refrigerator and serve.

2 Cans (7-oz. each) Tuna (drain & flake)	3 t Lemon Juice
1 Can Cream of Mushroom Soup	$\frac{1}{2}$ t Salt
$\frac{1}{2}$ C Fine Dry Bread Crumbs	2 T Butter
$\frac{1}{4}$ C Finely chopped Onions	1 C "extra dry" Bread Crumbs
1 Egg Beaten	

Mix well using only $\frac{1}{4}$ -can mushroom soup. Make eight croquettes. Roll in extra dry bread crumbs, cook in 2-T Butter about 15" browning out on both sides. SAUCE: Blend balance of soup ($\frac{3}{4}$ -C), $\frac{1}{4}$ -t salt, $\frac{1}{3}$ -C milk, 2-T Mayonnaise. HEAT: put croquettes in serving dish and pour sauce over top of croquettes.
