TABLE TALK

CHICKEN TETRAZZINI

- 1 Pkg. (7 oz.) thin spaghetti
- 2 Cans (8 oz. each) mushrooms, drained
- $\frac{1}{2}$  C butter or oleo
- 4 breasts of chicken, or 1 whole fryer cooked
- 2 cans cream of chicken soup, undiluted
- 2 C sour cream (ours) Grated Parmesan Cheese

Break spaghetti into 1" pieces, cook and drain. Saute mushrooms in butter. Remove skin and bones from chicken and cut into large pieces. Mix with mushrooms and remaining ingredients except cheese. Turn into buttered casserole and sprinkle with cheese, bake at 300 degrees for 40 minutes. Yield: 8 to 12 servings. Can be made ahead and refrigerated, or may be frozen for several weeks.

MARSHMALLOW BROWNIES

- 2 eggs
- $\frac{1}{2}$  C flour (all purpose)
- 1 C miniature marshmallows
- $\frac{1}{2}$  C chopped nuts
- 2 Squares unsweet chocolate
- $\frac{1}{2}$  C oleo or butter
- 1 C sugar
- 1 t vanilla
- $\frac{1}{2}$  C chocolate bits

Combine butter and 2 kinds of chocolate in a pan over hot water, stirring until all are melted and blended. Set aside to cool to lukewarm. Beat eggs until thick and lemon color, add sugar and beat. Stir chocolate mixture into egg mixture add flour, vanilla and blend. Add marshmallows and nuts and blend. Bake in (9" square pan at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.) Cool and cut into squares.
