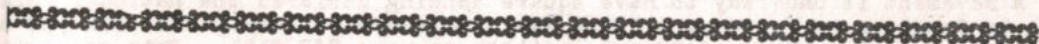
PRESIDENT'S NOTEBOOK

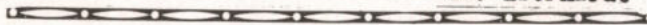

ASSOCIATION HI LIGHTS

As we go to press the membership in the West Coast Association stands at something over 3500. This is a new high. The rate of renewals has reached 50 % which is considered excellent so early in our campaign. We urge all members not to delay but to get your renewals in now.

We are informed that a first has been achieved by the Left Allamanders of St. Petersburg. They are the first club ever to attain 100 % membership in the West Coast Association.

On Sunday afternoon Nov. 29 46 squares of avid dancers gathered at Strawberry Square to dance to the calling of Bob Barnes and the cueing of Marty Martin. The Association gleaned 80 new members and 127 renewals, and 21 visitors also enjoyed the festivities. 16 couples in blue and white turned out to promote the '82 convention as is customary at all West Coast dances.

The Association wishes to express its appreciation to the caller and round dance leader for their cooperation and especially to the Martins for making their wonderful hall available for this dance. It is this cooperation which makes our association such a vibrant organization.



NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE

A movement is underway to have square dancing declared the national folk dance by Congress in February, 1982. The Senate has already passed SJR #59 and it is now up to the House of Representatives to pass HJR #151. This resolution requires co-sponsorship by 218 members of Congress in order for the resolution to be reported out of committee. Bill Chappell Jr. of Ocala and Bill Nelson of Melbourne are presently the only Florida congressmen among 64 Co-sponsors on board.

We ask all dancers and callers to write or call their congressman and urge him or her to become a co-sponsor of HJR #151. You can get the name of your congressman from your local library or newspaper office.

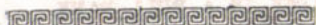

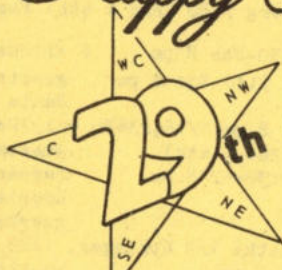
