This month with our travelling square we wandered down to Arcadia, to dance at the Palace. This is a dance hall built by square dancers for square dancing. The Martins, Everett and Jennie, who, incidentally do calling and cueing were the inspiration and the grand architects of this hall. The sound is good although the floor is not wood but what ever the composition is, it make very easy dancing, even with soft shoes. Holds ten squares very comfortably and many more intimately. Has a nice kitchen and the time we were there they served refreshments. Also a well supplied botique square dance shop and reasonably priced. Several clubs dance there and also have a beginners class. It is easy to find, right on Rt 17 just north of Arcadia. About 50 miles south of Lakeland and there is plenty of parking. Who can ask for more, of course the night we visited there was a Bow and Swing subscription dance. We all enjoyed the occasion for it was a real fun dance.
