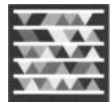

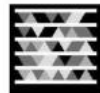

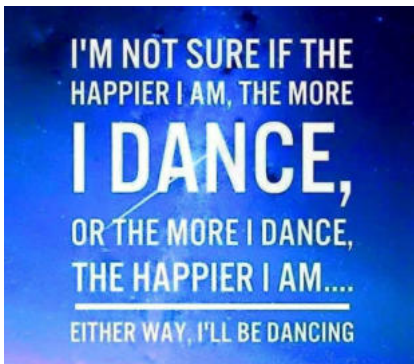

This position can be filled by one couple, two couples, a solo or two solos, someone from the Florida Callers Association, the Round Dance Council of Florida, or the Florida Square Dance Campers as well as the Federatrion.

There is a Convention Procedures document which provides you with valuable information on what to do and there is also a timeline document that provides you information on when everything needs to be accomplished. There are also numerous past convention chairman to serve as advisors.

Regarding the 2018 convention...

There are several positions that still need to be filled; Dangle Dances, Entertainment, Grand March, Hospitality / Security, Program Ads, Publicity / Promotion, Vendor Chair, Ways & Means, W/M Central, W/M Northwest, and W/M Southeast.

The responsibilities of each of these positions are as follows:

Dangle Dances - create dangle dance themes in coordination with the convention theme, schedule callers to call each dangle dance, work with Suzie Q Creations to design a dangle for each theme.

Entertainment - arrange for entertainment in the evenings - musical, dance demonstrations, etc.

Grand March - coordinate lining up everyone for the Grand March.

Hospitality/Security - coordinate the schedule of volunteers to greet at each of the entrances

Program Ads - coordinate with each of the associations regarding the renewal of ads and the purchase of new ads for their respective areas.

You do not have to live in Lakeland to fill this position. All of the ads are sent to the program booklet chairman.

Publicity/Promotion - write press releases for a the Bow & Swing, each of the association newsletters, local newspapers, etc.

Ways & Means - coordinate with the convention chairman as to what fundraisers will be done and make arrangements for them.

Ways & Means for Central, Northwest and Southeast - The state ways & means chairman makes the arrangements for each fundraiser and each of the associations needs a person to handle raffle ticket sales for their area.

We are not only facing the loss of dancers but also of workers. If we can't get volunteers to help put on these conventions, then we won't be able to continue having them.
