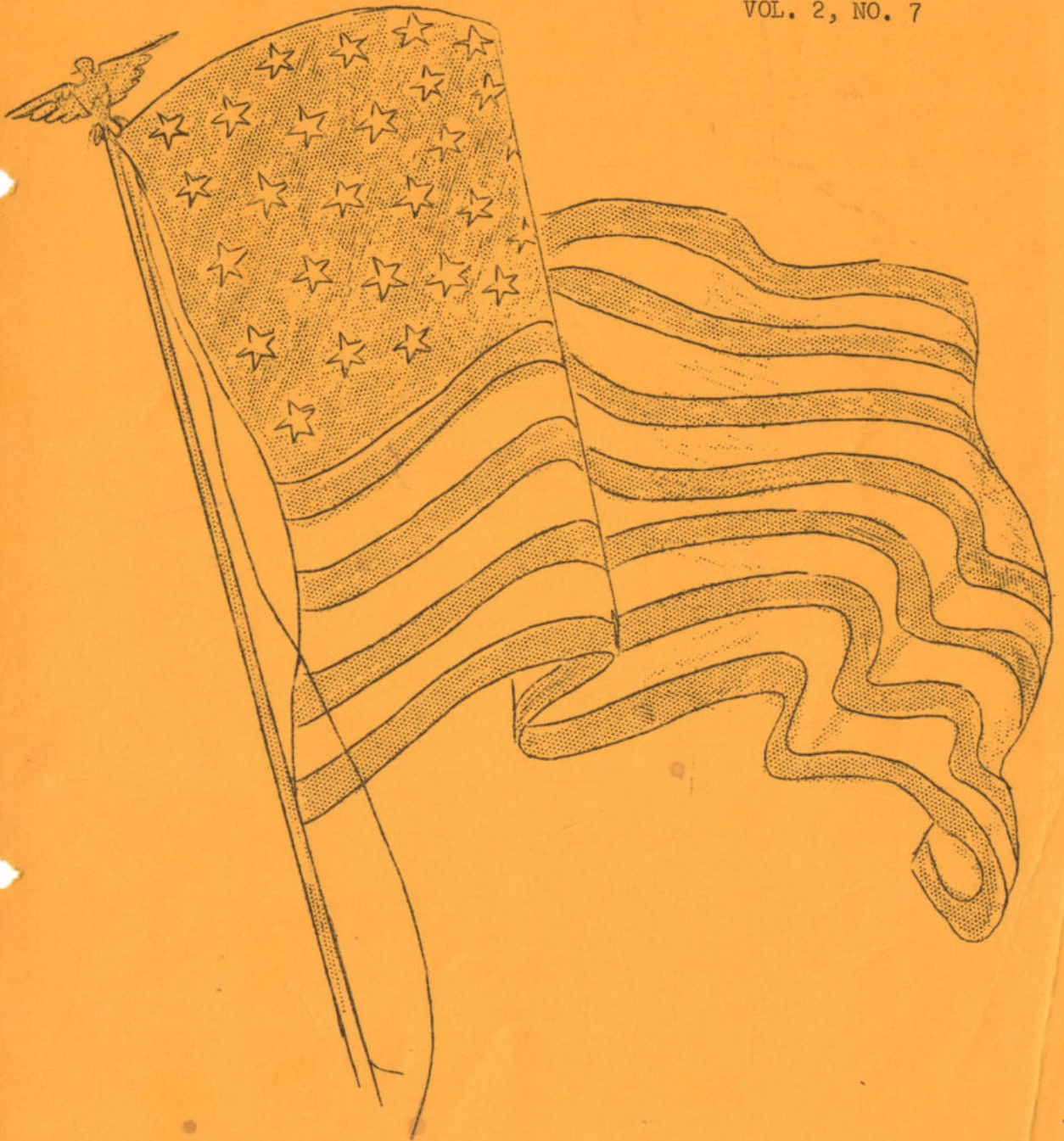

## STRAWBERRY CAKE

- 1-Box White Cake Mix
- 4-Eggs
- $\frac{1}{2}$ -C Wesson Oil or Crisco
- 1-Box (10 oz.) Frozen Strawberries
- 1-Box (3 oz.) Jello (Strawberry)

Blend cake mix, eggs, jello and oil for 1 minute. Add partially thawed strawberries and blend for 2 minutes. Pour into 13" x 9" x 2" greased and floured cake pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes. Serve with cool whip and 1 box frozen strawberries or strawberry ice cream.

## CRAZY PIE

- Melt  $\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\frac{1}{4}$  stick of oleo in (9"x9"x2") cake pan or a 9" pie pan.
- Mix  $\frac{1}{2}$ -C sugar,  $\frac{1}{2}$ -C flour, 2-t baking powder and  $\frac{1}{8}$ -t salt together and add  $\frac{1}{2}$ -C milk, blend all together.
- Pour over melted oleo but DO NOT STIR.
- Pour 1-can of any preferred fruit pie filling (Comstock preferred) over mixture but DO NOT STIR.
- Bake 30 to 45 minutes in 400 degree oven.

Record: DECCA #31812 "The Moon Is Making Eyes", Flip side "Moon Over Naples"  
 Position: INTRO: Open-Facing, M facing wall  
 Dance: Bjo-Pos M facing wall. Opp. Footwork.

## Measures

INTRODUCTION

1-4 WAIT; WAIT; APART,-,POINT,-; TOGETHER,-, (To Bjo-Pos) TCH,-;  
 1-4 In OP facing ptr do a standard acknowledgement to Bjo-Pos;;;;

PART A

- 1-4 POINT FWD,-,POINT BK,-; BJO AROUND,2,3,-; POINT FWD,-,POINT BK,-;  
BJO AROUND,2,3,-(to SCP);
- 1 In Bjo-Pos facing wall point L toe fwd, hold 1 ct, point L toe bk, hold 1 ct;
  - 2 Fwd L rotating around ptr, fwd R, fwd L to end facing COH, hold 1 ct;
  - 3 Point R toe fwd to COH, hold 1 ct, point R toe bk, hold 1 ct;
  - 4 Fwd R rotating on around ptr, fwd L, fwd R blending to SCP, hold 1 ct;
- 5-8 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; (Double Hitch) FWD,CLOSE,BK,-; BK,CLOSE,  
FWD,-;
- 5-6 In SCP progressing LOD do 2 fwd two-steps;;
  - 7 Hitch fwd L, close R to L, bk L, hold 1 ct;
  - 8 Hitch bk R, close L to R, fwd R, hold 1 ct;
- 9-12 POINT FWD,-,POINT BK,-; (Vine apart) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE,-; POINT FWD,  
-,POINT BK,-; (Vine Tog) SIDE,BEHIND,SIDE,-;
- 9 In SCP facing LOD point L toe fwd, hold 1 ct, point L toe bk, hold 1 ct;
  - 10 Releasing ptr vine to COH (W to wall) side L, R behind, side L, hold 1 ct;
  - 11 Point R toe fwd, hold 1 ct, point R toe bk, hold 1 ct;
  - 12 Vine to wall & ptr (W to COH) side R, L behind, side R, end SCP & hold 1 ct;
- 13-16 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; (W Twirl) WALK,-,2,-; 3,-,4,-;
- 13-14 In SCP progressing LOD do 2 fwd two-steps;;
  - 15-16 In LOD walk fwd 4 slow steps L,-,R,-; L,-,R,- (W twirl RF in 2 steps R,-,L,-; then walk fwd R,-,L,-) end in CP M facing wall;

ROUND OF THE MONTH (continued)PART B

- 1-4 (Vine) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, FRONT; WALK, -, 2, -;  
 (Vine) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, FRONT; WALK, -, 2, -;  
 1 Vine LOD side L, behind R (both XIB), side L, front R (both XIF);  
 2 Walk LOD L, -, R, -;  
 3-4 Repeat measures 1-2 of Part B ending Bfly-Pos facing wall;;  
 5-8 FACE, TO, FACE, -; BK, TO, BK, -; TWO-STEP AWAY; TWO-STEP TOGETHER;  
 5 (Bfly-Pos) Prog LOD side L, close R to L, side L, swing R ft & trailing hands thru (M turn away LF & W RF to bk-to-bk pos);

 7-8 Circle away L, R, L, -; & Together R, L, R, - in 2 two-steps M turning L to COH & W turning R to wall to end in CP with M facing wall;  
 9-16 REPEAT MEASURES 1-8 OF PART B -- end in Bjo-Pos facing wall.

SEQUENCE: A - B - A - B - A-----  
 ENDING: Last time thru Part A Measures 16---STEP APART, -, POINT, -;

NOTE:-----Part A can be used as a mixer of 16 measures. Omit the Twirl in measure 15. Substitute instead for measure 15 and 16 the following. M turn L and walk 4 slow steps RLOD to meet new ptr in Bjo-Pos to begin mixer again (W walk fwd 4 slow steps).
