FLORIDA FRUIT MOLD

- 2 3-ounce packages Lemon flavored gelatin  
 1 3-ounce package orange flavored gelatin  
 3 cups boiling water  
 2½ cups chilled ginger ale  
 1 16-ounce jar chilled unsweetened grapefruit sections, drained  
 1 papaya, cubed  
 1 banana, sliced

## Key Lime Dressing (below)

Dissolve gelatin in boiling water; add ginger ale, Chill until partially set; fold in fruit. Pour into oiled shallow 2-quart mold. Chill until firm. Unmold on serving platter. Serve with:

KEY LIME DRESSING

- 1 cup marshmallow creme  
 ½ cup mayonnaise  
 2 tbsps. lime juice  
 1½ tps. grated lime rind  
 ½ tsp. celery seed

Combine marshmallow creme, mayonnaise, lime juice, rind and celery seed; mix well. Chill. Makes 1 cup. 10 to 12 servings.

Variations: Substitute 12 cup Bundt pan for 2-quart mold; substitute melon balls for papaya.
