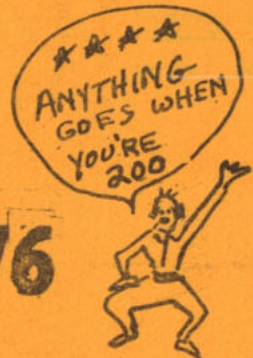

KITCHEN KOLUMN by Ginny Walthers CHOCOLATE BANANA PIE

2 oz. banana, sliced
8 oz. chocolate diet soda
1 T unflavored gelatin
1/3 C dry powdered milk
4 oz. creamed cottage cheese
1/2 t. W.L. chocolate extract
1/2 t W.L. brown food coloring
2 t artificial sweetner or to taste

Lay banana slices in bottom of 8
inch pie pan. Measure out 3/4 C
of soda in a saucepan. Sprinkle
gelatin over soda. Heat & stir.
Pour heated mixture into blender.
Add remaining soda & dry milk.
Blend. Add all remaining ingredients.
Blend well. Pour mixture over
bananas slices & refrigerate til
set. This equals 1 fruit portion
& 1 milk portion & 4 oz. cheese
portion.
