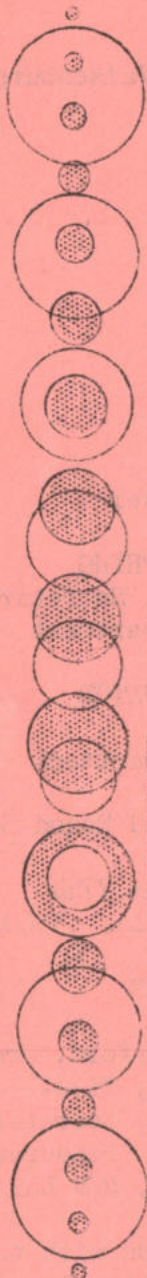

TABLE TALK

CHERRY SALAD SUPREME

- 1 3 oz. Package Raspberry Jello
- 1 21 oz. Can Cherry Pie Filling
- 1 3 oz. Package Lemon Jello
- 1 3 oz. Package Cream Cheese
- 1 8 3/4 oz. Can (1-C) Crushed Pineapple
- 1/3 C Mayonnaise or Salad Dressing

Dissolve raspberry jello in one cup boiling water, stir in pie filling. Turn into 9 x 9 x 2 baking dish, chill until partially set. Dissolve lemon jello in 1-C boiling water, stir in undrained pineapple. Whip 1/2-C whipping cream, (can use Dream Whip) fold into lemon mixture with 1-C miniature marshmallows. Spread atop cherry layer. Top with 2-T chopped nuts. Chill until set.

BANANA PEACH DELIGHT

- 1 Small Box Vanilla Wafers
- 1 C Powdered Sugar
- 1 t Vanilla
- 1 Large Can Peaches
- 1 Stick Butter
- 2 Eggs
- 3 Bananas
- 1/2 Pint Whipping Cream

Crush wafer crumbs, line pan 8 x 12". Beat butter, sugar, eggs and vanilla together. Spread atop of crumbs, place sliced bananas on top, then peaches. Spread with whipped cream and sprinkle a few of the crumbs on top. Chill thoroughly and serve.

YEAR-ROUND FRUIT CAKE (A recipe for Happiness)

- 2 C Love
- 1 C of Friendliness
- 1 C of Kindness
- 1 Pound of Long Suffering
- 4 t of Gentleness
- 1 Box of Faith
- 1 Pound of Peace
- 1 Box of Meekness
- 1 Pound of Joy

Mix all together and bake in the Oven of FORGIVENESS for two Prayer Hours. Then cool on the table of UNDERSTANDING. Suggested by Inez O'Donnell

SQUARE DANCE MANNERS

St. Petersburg (continued)

1. I will introduce myself to at least one new couple at each dance.
2. I will not "sit out" a dance if one more couple is needed to fill a square.
3. I will serve on the refreshment committee or otherwise do my share of club duties, whenever asked.
4. I'll try to look like I'm having a good time while I square dance.
5. I'll have a pleasant word for the caller, and not ignore him until I have a complaint.
6. I won't glare at my corner if he makes a mistake--after all, I sometimes miss too.
7. If I feel like shouting to show my exuberance, I'll do it during a pause in the call, and not when it will drown out the caller.
8. I'll leave the instruction to the caller, and not try to explain the dance to my own square.
9. I'll remember that personal grooming is important to my acceptance in a square dance group.
10. I'll keep my dancing "standard" unless I am sure that the rest of my square approves of those extra twirls, etc.
11. I'll remember that once upon a time I was a beginner, and be willing to dance with those who have had less experience than I have had.
12. I'll try to remember that "a stranger is a friend I haven't met."
