KITCHEN COLUMN

Impossible Pie (Made in blender)

2 Cups milk

3/4 Cup sugar

3/4 stick oleo

1/2 cup flour

1/2 cup coconut

1 teaspoon vanilla

4 eggs

Put all in blender & blend one minute. Pour into greased & floured 10 inch pie pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 40-45 min. or until lightly browned. Delicious - it forms its' own crust. Flour goes to bottom and coconut comes to the top, like coconut cream pie. Make sure your blender holds at least 1 qt. or 32 oz. You add a bit more vanilla if you'd like.
