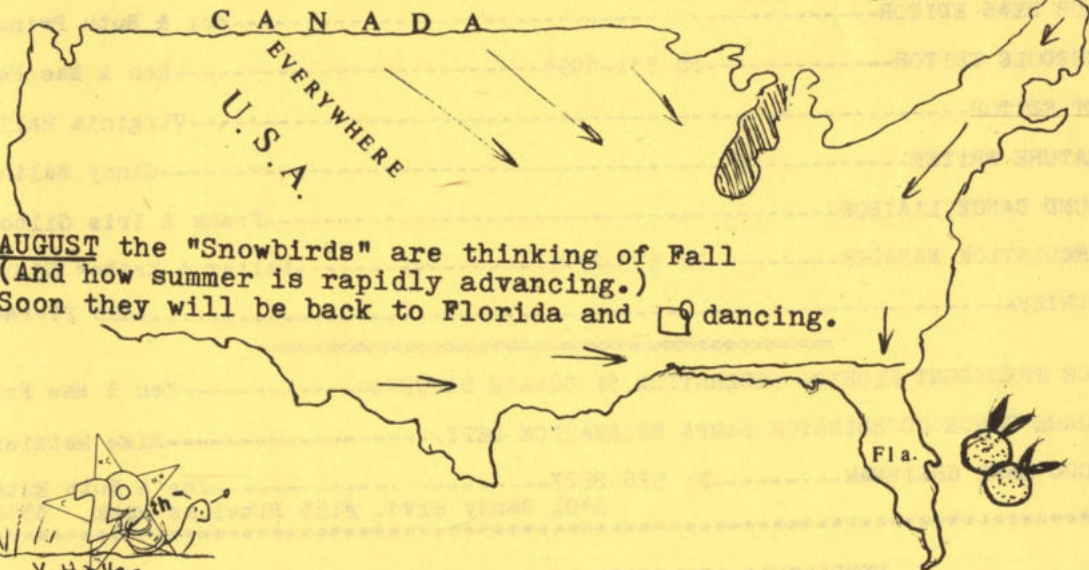

INCREASE IN RENEWAL FEE



The Governing Council of the West Coast Association, at their meeting April 22, voted to increase the renewal fee from the present \$1.50 per person to \$2.00 per person. There is to be no increase in the fee of \$3.00 a person for new members. This new schedule will be in effect for 1982 renewals effective October 1, 1981.

Although we try to keep our fees as low as possible, it is also important that we remain solvent if we are to be of maximum service to square and round dancers in our area. Costs have steadily increased over the years, principally the cost of our magazine due to dramatic raises in paper prices which have gone up three fold.

Please do not misunderstand, we are not broke. We can still pay our bills thanks to an extremely successful FALL FUN FEST last year, but in reviewing our treasurer's report, an increase was indicated if we are to remain solvent. This is the first increase in renewal fees since 1972, a condition which was only made possible by the large surge in membership since 1975. While we hope membership will continue to grow, the rate of growth will undoubtedly slow down.

We still firmly believe that, by providing free West Coast Dancers to all, free blood to those in need and several free dances a year, we are providing the best bargain square dancers can get anywhere.

COTTAGE EGGS

- 6 Hard Boiled Eggs
- $\frac{1}{2}$ c. Cottage Cheese
- 2 T. Mayonnaise
- Salt, pepper and Paprika

Slice eggs lengthwise and remove yolks. Mash yolks. Add cottage cheese and mayonnaise. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Then sprinkle with paprika.

HOLLY'S PEANUTTY CAKE



- 1 Pkg. fudge marble cake mix
- 1 cup dairy sour cream
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup crunchy peanut butter
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water
- 3 eggs
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped unsalted peanuts

Frosting

- 1 can ready-to-spread chocolate fudge frosting
- 2 Tbs. crunchy peanut butter
- 1 Tbs chopped peanuts (for garnish)

Mix first 5 cake ingredients for 2 minutes on highest mixer speed. Stir in peanuts. Pour $\frac{2}{3}$ batter in greased & floured pan. Add marble pouch plus 2 Tbs. water to remaining cake mixture and blend well. Spoon at random over yellow batter and marble by pulling knife in wide curves through the batter.

Bake at 350 for 35 to 45 min. (Use 2 round cake pans or 1 13X9 inch) Cool and frost. Garnish with peanuts.
