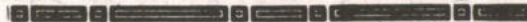


### SQUARE DANCE WEEK

# Editors Edditions

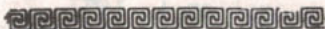

**KITCHEN KOLUM**

**RAISIN BRAN MUFFINS**

1 cup vegetable oil  
3 cups sugar  
4 eggs - beaten  
1 quart buttermilk

5 cups sifted flour  
5 teaspoons baking soda  
2 teaspoons salt  
1 box (15 oz.) Raisin Bran

Add all ingredients by steps. Mix well. Use greased muffin tins. Bake at 400° for 18 - 20 minutes.

Dough will keep in refrigerator for 2 - 3 months, which is great because the yield is several dozens of muffins. They taste even better if you let the dough stand for a day in the refrigerator.

For Honey Fans - use 2 - 2½ cups honey and ¾ quart buttermilk.

The updated edition of the National Directory will be published in March 1983. The deadline for club information is November 1, 1982.

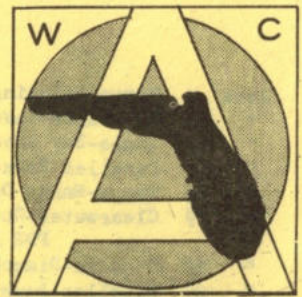
