Eight nominees were received by the Screening Committee of the Hall of Fame. Of these, five were passed on to the Nominating Committee and from this group three were selected to be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

All of the nominees were well presented with considerable research involved. Of those not selected it was felt the criteria of a significant effect state wide as a teacher, leader, organizer and/or promoter had not been met.

After serious consideration it was felt because of the difficulty in obtaining uniform photos that only plaques would be used. The plaque will be 11½" x 14" bearing the logo of the Hall of Fame, the name or names, date of induction and a brief resume'. The recipient or family will receive a smaller version without the resume'.

In the selection this year the committee had asked for those who had passed away. In two cases a decision had to be made whether to select even though one of the couple was still living. It was decided to use both names as they were so involved as a couple.

Those being inducted into the Florida Square and Round Dance Hall of Fame on Sunday afternoon, May 29, will be Kay and Ed Mack, Jim and Helen Galloway and Gene and Ima Baylis.

Kay and Ed were deeply involved in round dancing and one of the couples organizing the Round Dance Council of Florida with Kay serving as second president. They were one of the original Knothead couples and remained active as Round Dance Coordinator and MC's of the Knothead Convention. They were Directors of Evening Rounds at the National in Miami and served on the staff of the Square Dance Short Course at the University of Florida. For many years Ed was known throughout the country as the Clown Prince of Rounds.

Jim and Helen Galloway were one of the four original couples of Knothead. Both remained active in the Knothead Convention as Chairman and Treasurer and were the contacts for Knotheads throughout the state.

Gene and Ima Baylis were involved in both squares and rounds. They were instrumental in organizing the Round Dance Council of Florida with Gene as first president. Gene was caller and teacher for the Square Wheelers, a wheel chair club and exhibition group who for several years attended both the State and Knothead Conventions. He was active in the Florida Callers Association serving as president in 1957. They served on the staff of the Square Dance Short Course at the University of Florida.

The Screening Committee would like resumes' for nominees living or dead who were most active prior to 1966. This does not rule out renomination of any person or persons submitted and not selected in a previous year.

Once again the criteria is 10 years involvement in the Florida square and/or round dance activity and a significant effect state wide as a teacher, leader, organizer and/or promoter.
