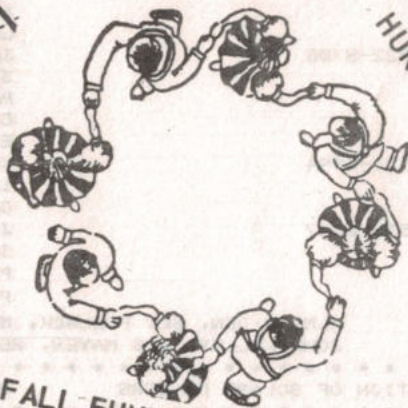

This is not to criticize Callerlab for its effort for it was only reacting to a demand for a system that would enable dancers to travel to the ends of the earth and be able to dance without fear of embarrassment or rejection. The concept was admirable and has served the purpose of standardization. Together we have challenged the dancers to excel, which in itself is not all bad, but it has become the tail which wags the dog.

Like so many wonder cures, no one anticipated the devastating side effects. Human nature being what it is, many dancers and callers strive for the higher levels without having learned the fundamentals. We now have dancers attempting 'A' and 'C' programs without having mastered the basics, or at least the mainstream list from all positions. Whatever happened to APD?
