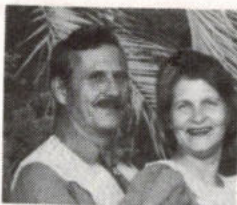

New to The West Coast area is The United Square Dancer of America Insurance program offered through The West Coast Square and Round Dance Association.

This program is being offered to only Dancer run Clubs and their members.

The Insurance program has two parts. First, General Liability Insurance Protection the club from claims of others for bodily injury and property damage up to \$500,000 and second, a \$10,000 limited accident coverage for each member of the club while engaged in dancing activities.

The annual cost of this program is \$1.15 per member with 100% club member participation required.

- 1 8 oz. pkg. noodles, medium size
- 1 12 oz. can corned beef, chopped
- 1 10 3/4 oz. can cream of chicken soup, undiluted
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup milk
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1 tsp. accent
- Buttered bread crumbs

Cook noodles according to pkg.; drain well
 Combine ingredients, except breadcrubs,
 stirring well. Spoon into lightly greased
 2 1/2 qt. casserole. Top with bread crumbs.
 Bake in 350° oven for 45 minutes, until
