## EDITORIAL

THE OLD SAYING "WHAT GOES UP MUST COME DOWN" DOES NOT ALWAYS HOLD TRUE. THERE ARE SITUATIONS WHERE SOMETHING THAT WAS "DOWN" FOR A LONG TIME MUST GO "UP". USUALLY, THIS IS TRUE WHEN WE TALK ABOUT COSTS. THIS TIME, WE MUST REGRETFULLY TELL YOU THAT THE PRICE OF BECOMING A WEST COAST MEMBER, AND THAT OF RENEWING YOUR MEMBERSHIP MUST GO UP, EFFECTIVE WITH THE 1989 SEASON.

THERE ARE A NUMBER OF FACTORS THAT ARE CONTRIBUTING TO THIS INCREASE FOR WEST COAST MEMBERS. FIRST, WE MUST REMEMBER THAT THE DUES HAVE NOT BEEN INCREASED IN 5 YEARS. DURING THIS TIME, WE HAVE SEEN THE COST OF DOING BUSINESS RISE STEADILY. ONE OF THE BIGGEST FACTORS IN OUR COST INCREASE IS THE RECENT INCREASE IN POSTAGE RATES. SINCE WE MAIL MANY RENEWALS AND NEW MEMBERSHIP BADGES ANNUALLY, OUR POSTAL COSTS ARE VERY HIGH. IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THE WEST COAST DANCER TO ALL OUR DANCERS EFFICIENTLY, WE BUY OUR OWN PAPER. THE COST OF PAPER HAS RISEN DRAMATICALLY AS HAS THE COST OF PRINTING THE DANCER. THE SAME CAN BE SAID OF ALL OUR OPERATING COSTS. ADD TO THIS THE PRICE INCREASE OF BADGES AND BARS AND YOU CAN EASILY SEE WHY IT BECOMES NECESSARY TO INCREASE OUR MEMBERSHIP AND RENEWAL FEES FOR NEXT YEAR. HOWEVER, TAKE HEART! THE INCREASE FOR RENEWALS AND NEW MEMBERSHIP WILL INCREASE BY ONLY 50 CENTS EACH. THUS, NEW MEMBERSHIP BECOMES \$4.50 PER PERSON, AND RENEWALS BECOME \$2.50 PER PERSON. IF YOU CONSIDER THE BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP, ESPECIALLY THE BLOOD BANK, THEN YOU KNOW THAT WEST COAST MEMBERSHIP IS STILL THE BEST BARGAIN FOR YOUR MONEY. WE SINCERELY HOPE THAT YOU WILL ALL BE UNDERSTANDING OF THIS AS YOU RENEW FOR NEXT YEAR, AND IF YOU ARE CONSIDERING BECOMING A MEMBER, PLEASE DO SO. REMEMBER, MEMBERSHIP IN THE WEST COAST AUTOMATICALLY ENTITLES YOU TO THE BLOOD BANK, PROVIDES FREE DANCES THROUGHOUT THE WEST COAST AREA, AND GIVES YOU THE WEST COAST DANCER MAGAZINE EVERY MONTH. PLEASE CONSIDER ALL THESE FACTS WHEN RENEWAL TIME COMES UP NEXT YEAR, AND GO FOR THE '89 BARS OR SEND IN YOUR NEW MEMBERSHIP.
