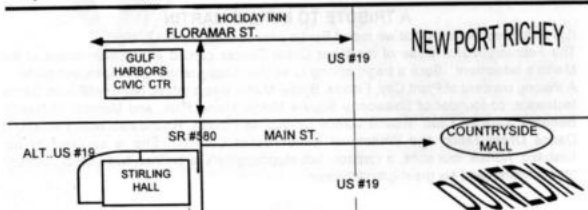

SOCIAL DANCING

Jazz up your fitness routine with a regular dose of dance.

Evelyn resolved that in 1994 she'd exercise regularly. But it's only the beginning of the new year and she's already bored with her new stationary bike. The rowing machine and treadmill at the YWCA also hold little appeal.

When a friend coaxed her to go along for an evening of free dance lessons, she realized exercise doesn't have to be a chore.

It's true. Whether you're swirling across the floor to a Strauss waltz or doing do-si-dos to the commands of a square dance caller, you're getting exercise - - and probably having fun too.

Dancing pairs you up with more than a partner.

From burning calories to socializing with friends, dancing offers these health benefits:

- **Calories** - Dancing can burn as many calories as walking, swimming or riding a bicycle. During a half hour of sustained dancing you can burn between 200 and 400 calories. One factor that determines how many calories you'll expend is distance. In one study, researchers attached pedometers to square dancers and found each person covered nearly five miles in a single evening.
- **Cardiovascular conditioning** - Regular exercise can lead to a slower heart rate, lower blood pressure and an improved cholesterol profile. Experts typically recommend 30 to 40 minutes of continuous activity three to four times a week. Dancing may not provide all the conditioning you need, but it can help. The degree of cardiovascular conditioning depends on how vigorously you dance, how long you dance continuously and how regularly you do it.
- **Strong bones** - The side to side movements of many dances strengthen your weight bearing bones (tibia, fibula and femur) and can help prevent or slow loss of bone mass (osteoporosis)
- **Rehabilitation** - If you're recovering from heart or knee surgery, movement may be part of your rehabilitation. Dancing is a positive alternative to aerobic dance or jogging.
- **Sociability** - Dancing contains a social component that solitary fitness endeavors don't. It gives you an opportunity to develop strong social ties which contribute to self-esteem and a positive outlook.

Would you like to dance?

Tomorrow night when you consider settling down for a little television, turn on the music instead. After a few spins around the living room, you'll have so much fun you may forget you're exercising.

BMI/ASCAP LICENSING PROCEDURES

Please be advised that there is no need for any Association, Club or Dancer in the State of Florida to contact A.C.A. or either of the licensing agencies for information and in fact would be detrimental for any dancer or association to do so.

The Florida Federation of Square Dancers has an existing agreement for licensing with both BMI and ASCAP. Therefore, no further requests for licensing information should be made to either of these organizations. Nor should A.C.A. be contacted for forms or other information.

This agreement, which has been in effect since 1990, pertains to dancer's association and/or club functions only and is separate from any agreement made with Callerlab, Roundalab or any other caller/cuer organizations.

The licensing agreement between the Florida Federation and BMI and ASCAP would be seriously jeopardized if any individual dancer or association contacted the agencies on their own. If you have any questions pertaining to licensing procedures for an event to be held within Florida please contact:

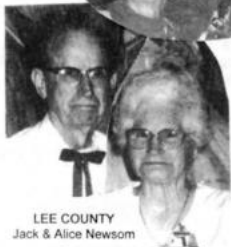
