STRAWBERRY SQUARE – PLANT CITY CELEBRATES TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY

The dance hall at Strawberry Square in Plant City was packed to capacity on March 21, 1999, when dancers (and former dancers), gathered to celebrate this joyous occasion.

Strawberry Square is the dream come true of Marty and Byrdie Martin, who were married in 1967 and were teaching rounds less than two years later. Their dream of a square and round dance hall and a mobile home park began to take shape in 1978 when they purchased property near their home and began to sell lots. Marty's son built the hall, with a beautiful floating wood floor, and the first dance was held in March, 1979. The hall is smoke free, can hold thirty-five squares and acoustics are excellent. Soon they were having dances every day of the week – what a joy to watch the happy square and round dance couples in their colorful outfits!

In 1995 the Martins decided it was time to retire, but rather than turn the operation over to an outside speculator, they elected to sell the entire facility to the park residents, who continue the tradition of fine dancing at Strawberry Square.

Unfortunately, Byrdie passed away in 1996, but Marty still lives in the park and can often be seen dancing in the hall, socializing and visiting with all who live there and who love him and appreciate all that he and Byrdie did to create this outstanding facility.

Almost 500 people attended the anniversary celebration! Bob Barnes and Art Springer called some square dance tips, and Charlie Lovelace cued some rounds. Bev Fowler (one of the residents) led some line dancing, and Joe Johansson did a splendid job as master of ceremonies. Joe opened the program by asking for a minute of silence in memory of Ken Anderson, a long time caller and resident, who had passed away just two days prior.

Midway through the festivities, there was a brief program in which Phil Thomas, President of the Strawberry Square Corporation, gave a brief talk summing up the history of Strawberry Square and introduced Ona Gunter, President of the Social Club. Ona announced the official naming of the social clubhouse (which used to be Byrdie & Marty's residence) "The Martin House". Phil presented an enlarged photograph of Marty and Byrdie to be hung in the Martin House, and Ona displayed the wooden name plaque which will hang over the entrance of the martin house. The program concluded with Marty Martin, himself, cueing a couple of round dances – for old times sake.


