COME FLY WITH US!!!
TO THE 50TH NATIONAL CONVENTION
IN ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA

The Florida Dance Web is putting together a group to fly to the National Convention in Anaheim, California on June 27-30 2001. This is not a tour or planned activities trip. It's only intent is to get the low round trip airfare which the airlines will provide if we reach a certain plateau. All registration, housing, etc. must be handled by you.

Here are the details on the flight. TWA flight # 469 departing Tampa @ 9:05 am on 26 June and arriving St. Louis @ 10:33 am. TWA flight # 37 departing St. Louis @ 11 :40 am and arriving at LAX airport at 1 :51 p.m. Bus transportation from LAX to your hotel will be available for \$13.50 (\$9.50 for each additional person).
