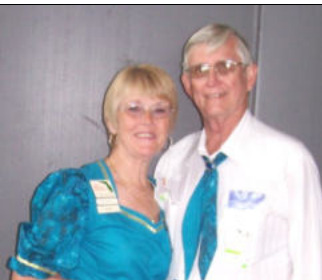
*A Note

2012 - 2013 WCSRDA **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**



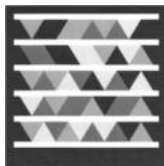
We are aware that not everyone is in agreement with our BIG move to go to a paperless W.C. Dancer by having it on our own web site. One objection was that "not everyone has a computer" and being said we've had a lot of complaints over the years that the Dancers was not getting to the clubs/dances and we feel we can reach more dancers this way. We feel we had a fair vote of this by sending out 33 ballots to the members that have been involved in the West Coast meeting during the past year, either by coming to the meetings or sending in their report to the meetings. There was a return of 25 ballots, with 23 voting for and 2 against. Some concerns we feel may be that we need some paper to hand out to people and this we want to cover by having a 1 page flyer printed that will have all the W.C. dances listed and on the back side a list of all the places with contacts of the places to dance in our 16 county area. Also we still want to have the small pocket size card that lists all the W.C. dances. We are still looking at having about 3 meetings a year but looking at having them in conjunction with/ prior to a W.C. dance.

We are still in the early stages of getting our web site designed and have several goals in mind some are: Look professional, easy to find, have a members only section that they will access using their email address, map of Florida that would have dots signifying where places to dance in our area are and would open to that information when 'clicked' on, a calendar showing where dances are by date, and links to all other Square Dance sites in Florida. We will need to collect all members' email addresses, you can give it to us now at anndonslocum@juno.com or we will ask for it during the next renewal of your W.C. membership –addresses will never be used or sold for any other purpose. We have obtained a domain name of www.flwestcoastdancer.com

We are looking for anyone who wants to be involved with this formation process, just tell one of the officers or Ed Henning. We would appreciate some help from someone who has some experience is this line.

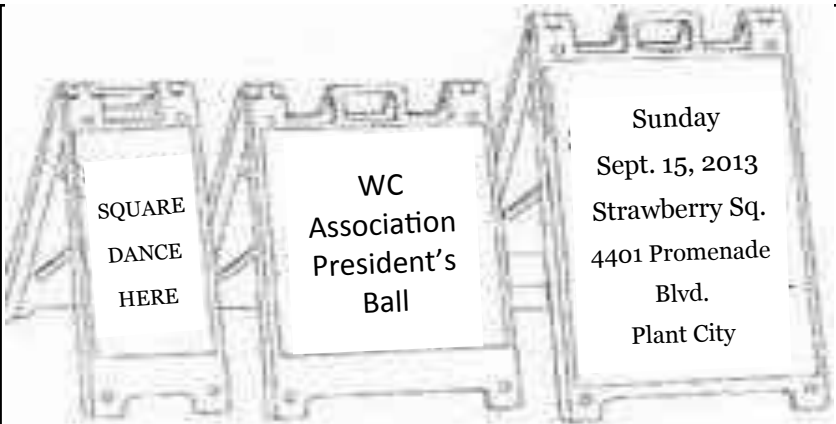

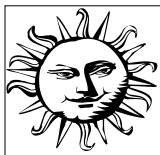
