NORWEGIAN MEATBALLS

|--------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 1 lb. Round Steak | $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. Lean Pork |
| 1 C Dry Bread Crumbs | $\frac{1}{2}$ C Water |
| $\frac{1}{2}$ C Milk | 1 tps Salt |
| $1\frac{1}{2}$ tps Sugar | $\frac{1}{8}$ tps Pepper |
| $\frac{1}{2}$ tps Mace | 1 Large Egg |

Have meat ground twice. Combine all ingredients, mix by hand thoroughly, the more kneading the better. Form into balls approximately size of large marbles. Brown in 2 to 4 Tps. hot vegetable shortening on med. high burner, turn over or shake the skillet so balls are browned all over. Makes approximately 90.

Saute onions in oleo on medium heat, add coffee and cover. Cook on simmer heat for 4 to 6 minutes. Arrange meat balls in dish and pour onion sauce over them. Let stand in refrigerator over night, serve warm. May be frozen.
