FRUIT COCKTAIL TORTE

- 1 1/4 C Unsifted Flour
- 1 C Sugar
- 1 Egg
- 1 t Soda
- 1/2 t Salt
- 1 Can (med.) Fruit Cocktail

Mix all ingredients together and pour into 9" x 9" x 2" baking pan, "greased." Sprinkle with 1 C brown sugar and nuts. Bake 45 minutes at 350 degrees. Serve with whipped cream or plain.

Serves 6

FROZEN DESSERT

Line a pan 13" x 9" x 2" with wax paper extending paper over edges to make it easier to lift out for slicing.

- 16 Macaroons (in a bag) crush fine
- 1/2 C Nuts cut fine
- 2 Pkgs. Dream Whip prepared as directed on package, or 3 C Cool-Whip
- 1 Quart Sherbert (two flavors can be used)
- 1/2 t Vanilla

Mix first four ingredients together in a large bowl. Spread 1/2 of macaroon mixture in lined pan. Place in freezer 15" to set. Soften sherbert and spread one flavor over mixture, next sprinkle a fine layer of macaroon mixture over sherbert. Spread other layer of sherbert on top and finely sprinkle the remaining macaroon mixture on top. Freeze for about 3 hours.
