ROUND DANCE BASICS

Have you ever thought why round dance teachers work so hard to have you do dance basics and steps correctly?? The only and complete reason is to get you to do them the "easy way". The person or persons who originally designed and worked out the details of the figures or steps made a thorough study of the body, foot and couple action to assure the details they published were the best possible way to do the steps and create good body flow. Executing the steps as outlined by the originators will, then, produce the easiest and best way to dance the figures.

Let us look at several figures and compare the correct way with the way they are danced by some people.--

1. The Forward Two-step---

The correct way is to step forward, bring the free foot directly beside the other foot and take weight, then step forward. (Using R/D description: Fwd L, Close R to L, Fwd L, Hold.) When the figure is done correctly it brings the weight over the feet on step two (Close R to L), then move forward on step 3 to the hold. This will give an almost continuous body flow forward.

Many dancers step forward on left, then do not close but bring the right foot to a point approximately at the heel of the left foot and take weight and then step forward. This gives the body a rocking action as the weight goes forward on the left, rocks back on the right, then forward on left with a distinct stop or hold on count four. Again, the correct way, as step 3 is taken the hold is used by drawing the right up to the left and under the body with no weight and a smooth preparation for moving the right foot forward for the next figure. It may be easily seen that the correct way eliminates the rocking action (which takes more energy) and makes a smoother, easier and better looking action.

We will continue with this series next month with Scissors, Whisk & Hitch. Frank & Iris Gilbert

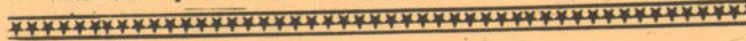
