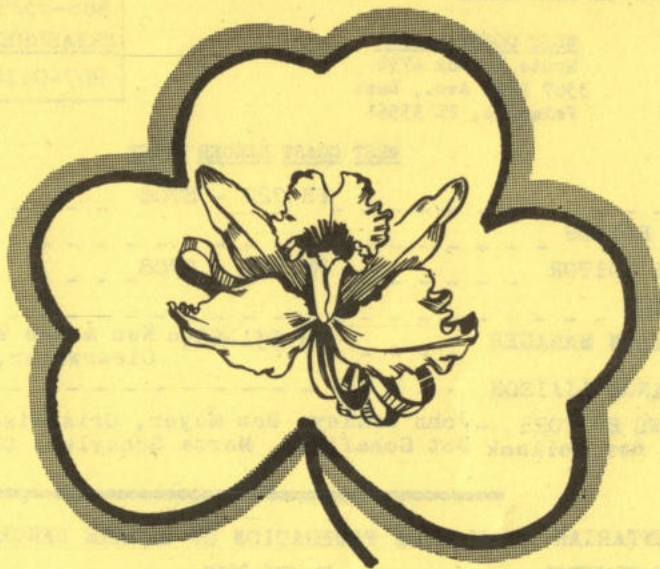

The Northeast Association of Square Dancers has designed a stunning multi-color costume to announce their coming Florida State convention at the end of the 83 convention. This costume is recommended by the Northeast Association for dancers to use at the National Convention during the following month in Louisville to represent Florida and generate interest in the Florida Convention.

Northwest Association leaders support the Northeast proposal.

Central Association leaders have embarked on the red & white outfit as proposed in Feb. Bow & Swing, pending further consideration.

West Coast Association leaders support the Northeast proposal by a large majority.

Southeast Association leaders opt for the red & white due to time considerations.
