5000 West Coast Dancer Magazines are printed and distributed each month. The West Coast Square and Round Dance Association which publishes the magazine has only 3400 members. Listed in the magazine are the group of 25 to 40 people who print, collate, count, bag and distribute the magazine to the clubs, callers and cuers.

It may be of interest to know that the paper and printing of the magazine cost \$3700.00 a year. The cost of badges and year bars for members cost \$3100.00 a year and the West Coast Dances cost around \$850.00 per year. Other costs, such as postage, Blood Bank, other printing, dues and ads run about \$1000.00. The publication of the West Coast Dancer for information to all dancers, callers and cuers, whether members or not is the main project of the Association. The Blood Bank is of almost equal importance in view of the fact that over 300 pints have been donated to dancers over the years with a reserve of over 500 units. The 11 or 12 West Coast Membership Dances scheduled all over the area are free to members and used by the Association as an easy way for you to become a member and renew your membership.

As you can see, the \$2.00 membership renewal fee does not cover the costs, so the Fall Fun Fest was introduced as a project to start our winter and make a profit to offset some costs not covered by renewals and new members. So far we feel it has been quite successful; and, moving it to the second weekend in November should be even more so. By supporting the Fall Fun Fest you are assuring a strong West Coast Association while having fun and we do not have to raise the cost of membership.

If you have not renewed your membership or joined the West Coast Association the use of the application at the bottom of the front inside cover would make it possible for the Association to offer further benefit in the years to come.

## IS STYLING GOING OUT OF STYLE?

For square dancing to be graceful, elegant, rhythmic and a pleasure to do and watch, styling is required. Neither acrobatic endeavors nor stiff, plodding drill-field execution adds elegance to our dancing.

For harmonious simplicity and polished, flowing, artistic movements through a singing call, or even hash, nothing can take the place of styling.

Round dancing emphasizes styling. Why is square dance grace and old-world classic charm no longer deemed important enough to emphasize in our classes?

Four areas come to mind when considering styling:

**WEAVING** -- Should be a smooth flowing motion of dancers passing each other, but all too frequently more of a physical endeavor of bumping and hand smacking.

**SWINGING** -- Certainly one of the most exhilarating motions in our dance when done simply and gracefully, not as a continuous whirling top.

**THE COURTESY TURN** -- Is there not a universally accepted execution of this elegant and formal movement? Man's palm up, lady's palm down; man's right hand in a delicately, but firmly, guiding position at the lady's back. Forearm seizing or finger clutching lends no grace.

**SKIRT WORK** -- Ladies, have you forgotten the oh so feminine, alluring hand work with your beautiful skirts and petticoats? We men are attracted and enticed by the charm of your mannerisms.

Probably there are other styling qualities that come to mind and are often neglected. Many exhibition groups have practiced styling down to a beautiful science and benefit from it. Perhaps we can take a lesson from these groups we often admire. Our club dances could become a charming new picture of grace and beauty through emphasis on styling by our callers in class.
