I know that quite a number of West Coast members have donated but when it was not possible to transfer the donation to the Community Blood-bank in St Petersburg they instead gave to different organizations. However this did not mean we were not able to transfer Blood to this area, we have in fact in the past month received 6 units from the St Petersburg Bank. At the moment we do not want to use this Reserve Account but want it to increase. Right now we have 22 units. Bob Richard who is a member of San Lan Square has donated most of it. I have given 1 unit, Bake Baker has donated several units. If you do make this gift of Life, please let me or Bob Richard know so we can give you the credit.
