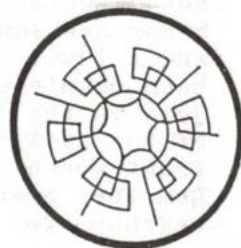
For your information, we have been asked by several dancers (callers also, we might add) what the Circle of Service Award is and therefore, we are expanding on that subject at this time.

The Circle of Service for Dancers Only, was the "brain Child" of Mori Sogolow of Plant City, who in the spring of 1985 had been asked to be moderator of a Legacy panel on Awards and Recognition.

After conferring with Chet Vetter, also of Plant City, then Chairman of Legacy's Leadership and Education committee, Kit Waldorf of Pensacola, was asked to design the emblem. Within 30 days after it was presented to Legacy, requests for the award were received from all around the world.

The citation accompanying the presentation of the Award reads: "This Circle is a symbol of service to square and round dancing. It is designed to be worn with PRIDE by dancers who, for three or more years, are determined to have made a significant contribution to the square and round dance movement.

The stellar hub of the Circle, formed by a pattern of arcs, symbolizes the importance of each such individual to the total picture. The same circular shapes flow outward to help define interlocking squares and stylized musical symbols. This linear interplay suggests the strong bond between the two "sister" dance activities, square and round dancing."



Presentation of this Circle of Service should be made to dancers only, as in I'm Just A Dancer." Those presenting the Circle must have themselves been the recipient at an earlier date. Through this method of presenting the honor, it was felt the Circle would gradually spread throughout the dance activity, thus honoring and recognizing those whose accomplishments have for so long gone unrewarded.

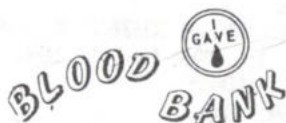
BLOOD BANK REPORT

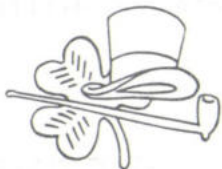
