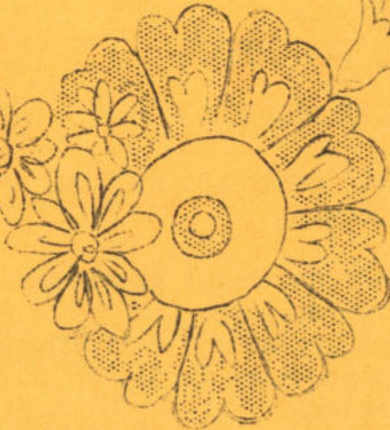
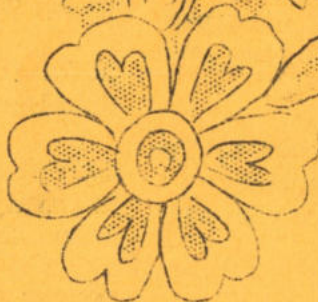
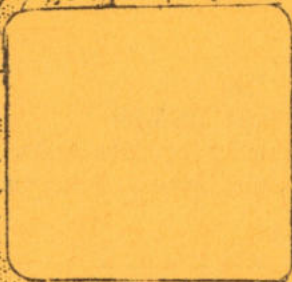

HELLO DOLLIE COOKIES

- 1/4 Lb. Butter or Oleo
- 1 C Graham Cracker Crumbs
- 1 C Flaked Coconut
- 1 C Semi Sweet Chocolate "cut fine"
- 1 C Chopped Nuts
- 1 C Sweetened Condensed Milk

Melt butter in a 9" square cake pan, sprinkle graham cracker crumbs over the butter and press down. Sprinkle coconut, chocolate and nuts in layers over crumbs.

DO NOT STIR. Pour milk over nuts and bake 30 minutes in 325 degree oven, cool and cut in squares.

- 2 Pkgs. Strawberry Jello
- 1 1/4 C boiling water
- 1 Can "small" 8 1/2 oz. Crushed Pineapple
- 2 Pkgs. Frozen Strawberries
- 1 Carton Sour Cream "1/2 pt."
- 2 Bananas

Pour water over jello and stir to dissolve, stir-in strawberries and undrained pineapple. Pour 1/2 of mixture in pan and place in the refrigerator to congeal. Spread sour cream over above, slice on the bananas, add the remaining half of the mixture which is partly congealed so fruit won't float, chill and serve.

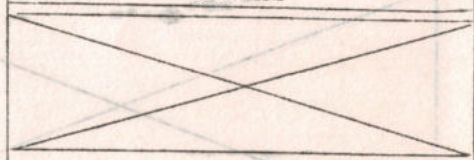

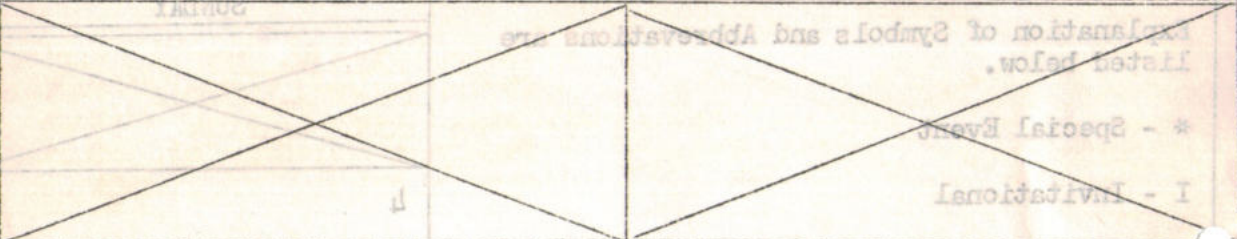
