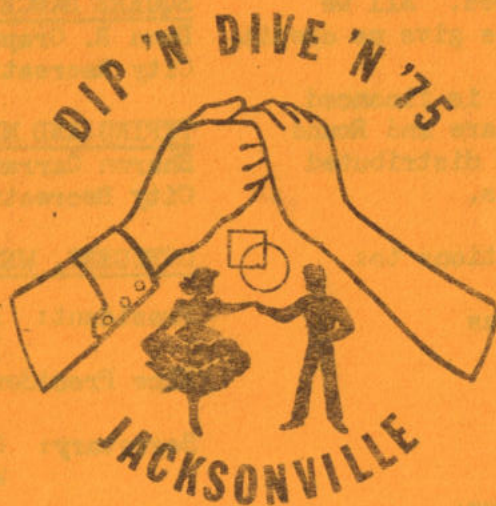

TOFFEE COOKIES

- 1 cup margarine  
 1 cup brown sugar  
 1 egg yolk  
 1 tsp. vanilla  
 2 cups cake flour  
 8 to 10 small plain Hershey bars (chopped nuts, optional)

Cream margarine and sugar, add egg yolk and mix well. Add vanilla and flour, mix thoroughly. Spread on cookie sheet about 1/8 thick and bake in 350 over 15 to 20 minutes. While still warm place Hershey bars over top and let melt and spread as for frosting--sprinkle with chopped nuts. Cut in squares while still warm.

A quick and easy dessert.

APPLESAUCE CAKE

- 1 lb. graham crackers  
 1/4 lb. margarine  
 2 cans applesauce

Crumble graham crackers into melted shortening, mix well. Put half the crumb mixture in square pan. Spoon applesauce over crumb mixture and put remaining crumbs on top. Gently pull applesauce away from sides with fork so crumbs will slip down. Bake 15 minutes in 350 oven until slightly browned. May be served warm or cool with cream or cool whip.

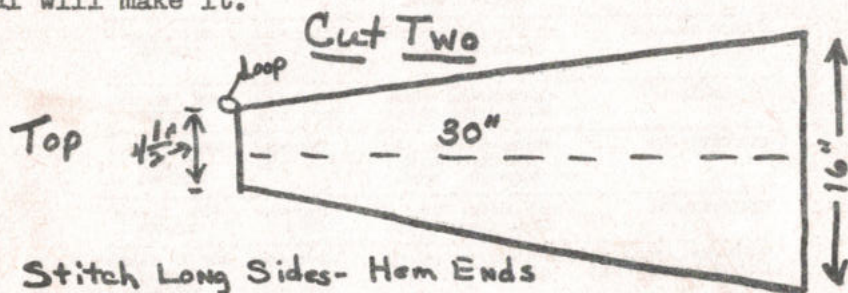
More Hints for New Dancers (LADIES)
