STATE CONVENTION GRAND MARCH

It's Convention time again, May 22, 23 and 24 at Lakeland, and we hope that all of you have registered. It's going to be another great one, with all members of the Florida Callers Assoc. and the Round Dance Council of Fla. given the opportunity to display their talents.

This year a new format for the GRAND MARCH is being used. It is patterned after that used at the National Convention in Oklahoma City. Many of you may be interested in seeing how it works and in being a part of it. It will take place on Saturday night after the exhibitions. Dancers will be entering from four positions, the entrances beside the stair in the Arena. There will be designated "lead" couples at each entrance which have been assigned numbers as follows:

Northeast entrance is No. 1, Southeast entrance is No. 2, Northwest entrance is No. 3 and Southwest entrance is No. 4.

WEST COAST dancers are to assemble in lines of four dancers (2 couples) behind the designated "lead" couples at entrance No. 2 (SE). The march will proceed in spirals according to the instructions of the Director. Dancers from other areas have been told the entrances they should use. Let's make a good showing for the WEST COAST.

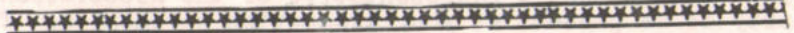
KITCHEN KOLUM

MICROWAVE PEANUT BRITTLE

- | | |
|-----------------------------|------------------|
| 1 C. sugar | 1 t. butter |
| 1 C. roasted salted peanuts | 1 t. vanilla |
| 1/2 C. white corn syrup | 2 t. baking soda |

In a 1 1/2 quart casserole dish stir together the sugar and syrup. Cook at high (full power) for 5 minutes. Stir in peanuts and cook another 5 minutes until light brown. Add butter and vanilla to syrup and peanuts, blend well. Cook 2 minutes more. Peanuts will be lightly brown and syrup very hot. Remove from microwave and add the baking soda and gently stir until light and foamy. Pour quickly on greased or buttered foil. Work it out until it is as thin as possible. Ready to eat in 45 minutes.



TIPS FOR TAWS

Here's help for strawberry time! You can keep strawberries firm for several days if you store them in a colander in the refrigerator, which allows the cold air to circulate between them. Never hull the strawberries until they have been washed or they will absorb too much water and become mushy.
