NEWS ABOUT THE STATE OUTFIT

Belle Bishop, president of the Federation and coordinator of the state outfit says there will be a further delay in obtaining the yellow material for the dress. Burlington Mills and Cloth World now project a mid-to-late April date so maybe by the time you get this it will be available.

The men's shirt worn with the 1981 Northwest Convention outfit is the same one to be used for the state outfit. If you already have this shirt it may simply be trimmed.

In spite of the difficulties encountered we would like to see a lot of "Florida outfits at the conventions. And we do appreciate your patience.

As the result of balloting by the 15 member Selceton Committee of the Hall of Fame five couples will be inducted into the Hall of Fame. The ceremony will take place at 7Pm in the Lakeland Civic Center Arena on May 26 during the State Convention.

Those being inducted are Don and Marie Armstrong of Hudson, Jimmy and Elizabeth Clossin, Orlando; Bart and Ruth Bartley of Gainesville, Harry and Helen Moore, Miami Beach and Al and Dot Cody of Kissimmee.

Armstrongs were instrumental in forming the Florida Callers Association and the first two State Conventions. The Clossins moved to Orlando in 1950 and nationally known as a caller and publisher became active with caller and dancer seminars throughout the state. The Bartleys along with Moores and Blaums worked several years to bring the National to Florida. Both were involved with the Callers Association and Ruth with the Round Dance Council. Moores worked to form the Florida Federation of Florida, serving as first president and were General Chairman of the National at Miami Beach. Al and Dot Cody were also involved with the establishing of the Federation and assumed responsibility as editor and publisher of "Bow & Swing" in 1957 and 58.

The inductees or their representatives will be presented with a smaller version of the plaque to be mounted in the Hall of Fame at Strawberry Square. They will also be honored at the Hall of Fame Dance which will be held at Strawberry Square on Sunday afternoon November 4, 1984. Chet Vetter

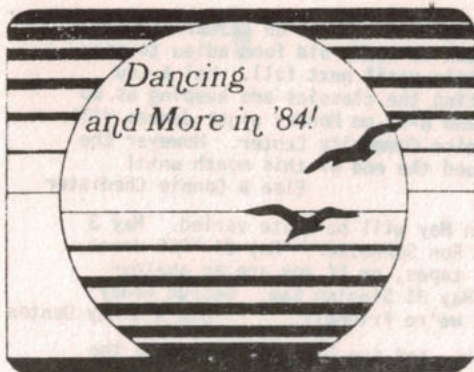
