

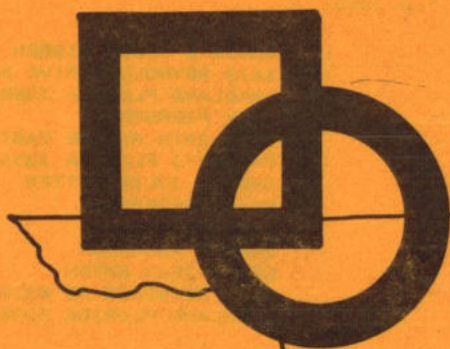

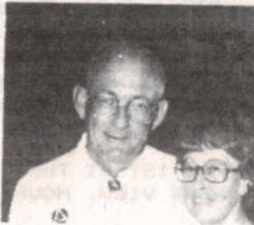

Departing from Philadelphia on a United flight to Pasadena the day after Christmas- hard to believe we could be so lucky. Arriving in California we were met by our chaperon, Bill Myrick, escorted to our motel and then to a meeting of, and a rehearsal with, the five other couples. A get-acquainted dinner held the following night provided our introduction to Peggy and Charlie Naddeo, one of the original organizers of the Square Dancers of America ten years ago. Fittings and rehearsals filled the following days, 9 to 12 Noon was the hard and fast schedule. Our first sight of our S/D. float was truly a thrill--what a tremendous undertaking.
