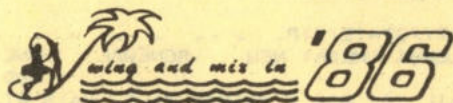

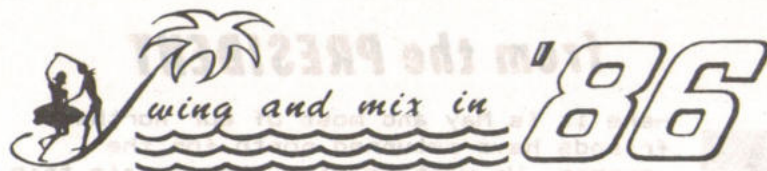


KITCHEN KORNER

Icebox Macaroni Salad

| 7 oz. Creamettes Macaroni
(2 cups dry) | 1 cup diced Cheddar cheese |
| 2 tbsp. salad oil | $\frac{1}{2}$ cup mayonnaise or salad dressing |
| 2 tbsp. vinegar | 1 17 oz. can peas (drained) |
| 1 tbsp. minced onion | 1 cup diced ham or chicken |
| $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. seasoned salt | 1 cup diced celery |
| $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. seasoned pepper | |

Cook macaroni according to package directions--do not chill. While still hot drizzle with oil and vinegar. Add onion, seasonings and cheese; toss well. Gently mix in canned peas and remaining ingredients. Chill thoroughly. Serve on salad greens. 6 to 8 servings.
