Here we are finally writing the last article before The State Convention. The program is being finalized and we are very proud of it. Earl Steele The Caller Vice Chairman and Frank DuBois The Round Dance Vice Chairman have truly put the final touches on a program designed for you The Dancer.

We understand that some dancers are unable to attend the whole week-end of dancing. If you can only attend one part or two of the Week-end a split fee is available at the door for just those segments you can attend. This is done to fit your particular situation and will allow you to attend this convention and enjoy Florida's best callers and round dance leaders. Sally and I hope you will take advantage of this reduced fee and join us for part of the 34th State Square and Round Dance Convention if you are unable to attend the entire festival.

To repeat some of the reasons we think you will enjoy this convention there will be continuous open hall format, changing the stage in the arena for better sound, opening the plus hall to add more room and revise the speaker set-up, nearly doubling the hall size for A-1 dancing, and planning over 12 hours for A-2 dancing. THE NEXT ITEM IS THE CITY, FROM THERE TO THE CALLERS LAST NAME YOU PUT IN LOCATION, LEVEL, RDS OR SQRS, OR WHATEVER YOU HAVE ROOM FOR. ENDING THE LISTING WITH THE LAST NAME OF THE CALLER OR CUER.

The object of all this is to promote friendly visits between clubs. For those who are not aware of it there are guidelines for banner stealing to be followed to make it a fun, friendly event. For all you Banner Bandits, these are the guideline to help make you a good "bandit."



REGISTER NOW FOR STATE S/R DANCE CONVENTION

1. Make it a practice to retrieve your banners before stealing others.
2. A minimum of four couples, or one square, paying guest admissions, constitutes a banner raiding party.
3. One full square should be present for the first and last tip.
4. Raiders may not retrieve and steal banners at the same dance.
5. A raiding club may not "reserve" a banner from the club to be raided.
6. There is no restriction on the number of "traveling" banners a club may have.
7. The first full raiding party to sign the guest register, if more than one raiding party arrive, should be awarded the banner.
8. A period of at least one month should pass before a club steals another clubs banner a second time.
9. It is discourteous for a banner to remain in limbo more than three months.
10. Banners should be available to any open dance on the clubs regular dance night and location unless advertised as "not available".
11. Banners should not be "stolen" from clubs who dance the same night as the raiding club.



These guidelines for you banner bandits were prepared by a joint committee of Suncoast Callers Association and West Coast Square and Round Dance Association.
