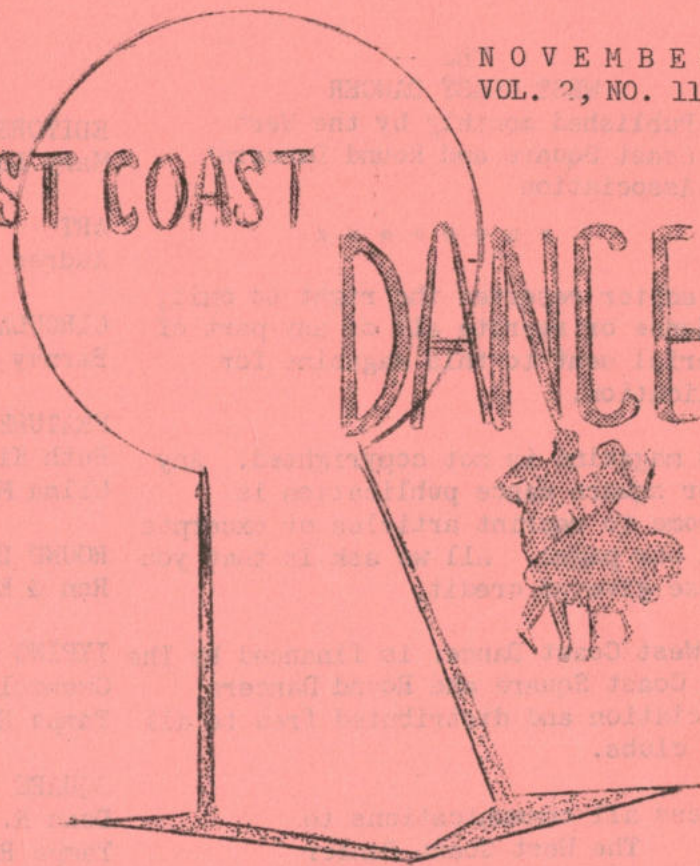

HAM LOAF

3/4 lbs. Ground Ham	1/4 t Pepper
3/4 lbs. Ground Pork	1/4 t Salt
2 Eggs "beaten"	1 t Sugar
1/2 C Milk	
1/2 C Bread Crumbs	

Mix ham and port, add eggs, milk, bread crumbs, pepper, salt and sugar.

Mix all together and shape into loaf. Place in greased baking dish and bake 1/2 hour at 325 degrees. Remove from oven and score top then spoon sauce over loaf, reinstall in oven and bake for 1 hour at 325 degrees. Serve.

SAUCE

1/2 C Brown Sugar	1/2 C Orange Juice
-------------------	--------------------

1/2 t Prepared Mustard	
------------------------	--

Bring to a boil and spoon over loaf after scoring.

CALIFORNIA DIP

1 Pint "Helman's" Mayonnaise	1 t "level" "Accent" onion powder
1 1/2 C Buttermilk	1 t "level" Garlic Powder
1 t "level" Salt	
1 t "level" Coarse Ground Pepper	

Mix, but do not heat.

It will blend in refrigerator, and keep indefinitely and is low in calories. Can be used on baked potatoes and green vegetables, as well as a chip dip.
